Classroom Use Ideas

- Weather/News castor
 - Students could record the classroom/school newsletter with images and video in the background.
- Where in the World am I from? Writing activity and online guessing game using Twitter and YouTube.
- Culture and Traditions
 - Students create green screen video based on their celebrated cultures and traditions.
- Read a story but stop short and do not read the end of the story. Students can finish the
