Classroom Use Ideas

- Weather/News castor
 - Students could record the classroom/school newsletter with images and video in the background.
- Where in the World am I from? Writing activity and online guessing game using Twitter and YouTube.
- Culture and Traditions
 - Students create green screen video based on their celebrated cultures and traditions.
- Read a story but stop short and do not read the end of the story. Students can finish the ending to a story by writing the ending then acting it out using green screen video.
- Students can create a reader's response to any story using green screen video.
- Book review
- Imagine that you are a superhero. What would be your super hero name? What is your secret superhero power? How do you help people with your superhero powers?
