




Regional Stormwater Protection Team (RSPT) Meeting Minutes

Wednesday, 06/21/23, 1:00 – 2:30 PM

 - **John Made motion to approve the minutes.** Ryan gave 2nd. None oppose. **Motion passed.**
- **Guest presentation - [Blue Thumb](#) Representatives (Laura, Becky Rice & Jacqueline)**
 - Blue thumb is a partnership between Public Organizations (watershed/conservation districts, agencies, cities), Minnesotans (citizens/volunteers/gardeners), Private businesses (Landscapers, designers, native plant nurseries, non-profits).
 - Website has lots of information on plant selection, partners, and learning opportunities. Lots of use of the online resources
 - Workshops
 - Some are free like turf alternatives
 - Live online workshops -typically hosted by a local group and Blue Thumb provides some experts to talk.
- **Lawns to Legumes Program**
 - Duluth area- 196 applied for L2L program- 106 awarded - 39 completed project
 - How to bring up the completion rate? The challenge and opportunity!
 - Many are new gardeners
 - Lots of resources available for RSPT if partnered - from signs to coloring sheets to interactive display
 - Partner workshops and trainings-
 - soil training
 - sustainable landcare
 - Funding & criteria
 - LCCMR now legislative funded
 - criteria include rusty patch BB and monarch ranges

 - Let's collect some data:
 - No boost posts = hit about 0 - 500 accounts when Joe posted:
 - 5 posts w/NPF topics (06.12-06.16.23) & 1 post w/original NPF content (06.19.23)
 - Boost posts = For \$20 and a geo-area of Duluth+30 miles we can reach between 485 and 1,400 account centers per day
 - Account centers are different than people, but not really ...
 - Definition of "Accounts Center accounts" = An Accounts Center account refers to either (1) an individual Facebook or Instagram account that has not been added to the same Accounts Center as another account, (2) the two or more Facebook and Instagram accounts that have been added to the same Accounts Center.
 - Basically testing out some posting boosts!
