1. Alternative Options to Fulfill PE Credit Policy

1.1. Summary:

Students who participate in OSAA sports and complete an entire season may be eligible to receive one quarter of PE credit (0.25) per sport*. A student may use two sports seasons during their high school years to earn a maximum of 0.5 PE credit. All students are expected to complete 0.5 credit in PE courses at Kings Valley Charter School/previous high school. The request for PE credit for athletic participation is made at the end of a student's junior year or in the first semester of a student's senior year.

1.2. PE credit for participation in OSAA Sports:

PE credit may be earned for participation in OSAA sports as an alternative credit option as outlined below:

1. Students may not apply for such credit until the end of their junior year.
2. Qualifying students are responsible to present the completed PE Credit request form to the Educational Director for final approval in a timely manner (by the end of the first semester of senior year).
3. A maximum total of 0.5 credit may be earned for sports participation (2 sports seasons @ 0.25 credits each in either the same or different sports).
4. All students are required to complete 0.5 PE credit on the school campus through their high school experience.
5. The athletic director will maintain records of all OSAA teams and their members.
6. Student must have successfully completed the season in order to receive credit. Successful completion must be verified by the coach or athletic director.
7. Credit will be recorded as P (Pass) grade. Letter grades (A - F) will not be issued.
8. Any violation of the Student Athlete Contract will make the student ineligible for credit in that sport season.

1.4. Alternate PE Activity Credit:

Students may earn up to 0.5 credit from alternative pe activities that can be verified by an instructor (martial arts classes, yoga, etc.)

Successful participation and completion of 33 hours during a semester during grades 9, 10, 11, & 12 may qualify a student for 0.25 credit in PE. Up to 0.5 PE credit may be earned in this manner. All students are expected to complete 0.5 credit in PE courses at Kings Valley Charter School/previous high school

Requirements:

- Application for such credit is to be made during the end of the student's 11th grade year or the first semester of the 12th grade year.
- Available for participation in pre-approved athletic activities only.
- The student is responsible for filling out the Pre-Approved Athletic Activities Log to track their hours participating in pre-approved athletic activities.
- A maximum total of 0.5 PE credit may be earned through pre-approved athletic activities.
- All students are required to complete 0.5 credit of pe at school.
- Successful completion of 33 hours for 0.25 credit or 66 hours for 0.5 credit must be verified by the instructor.
- Credit will be recorded as P grade (Pass). Letter grades (A - F) will not be issued.
