Privacy Policy

How is Personally Identifiable Information stored?

We may disclose information when legally compelled to do so, in other words, when we, in good faith, believe that the law requires it or for the protection of our legal rights or when compelled by a court or other governmental entity to do so.

While we take commercially reasonable measures to maintain a secure site, electronic communications and databases are subject to errors, tampering and break-ins, and we cannot guarantee or warrant that such events will not take place

and we will not be liable to Visitors or Authorized Customers for any such occurrences.

Children Under Thirteen

The Company does not knowingly collect Personally Identifiable Information from children under the age of thirteen. If a User is under the age of thirteen, they must ask their parent or guardian for permission to use this Website.

Use of Cookies And Pixels
