### Opening

# **Approval of Minutes**

May 2022 and August 2022 meeting minutes were presented. Stephanie Parkkila was added in attendance to the May 2022 meeting. Alison Asbury moved to approve as amended. Kim Triplett seconded. Unanimously approved.

# **Treasurer's Report**

The September 2022 Treasurer's Report was presented by Stephanie Parkkila. The opening balance was \$21,425.82, then had an income of \$4,053.04 and expenses of \$3,152.86. The Book Balance was \$22,326, with a Bank account amount of \$22,247.90. The difference was to a pending charge for school pay of \$78.10. Motion for approval by Kelly Pittman, seconded by Jessie Solognier. Unanimously approved.

### **Communications Report**

Amy Dannemiller gave the communications report.

- Next week is "Hello" week and each day has a different activity planned.
- For shirt orders, one order was possibly delayed but now should be on time.
- School shirts will be in on September 16<sup>th</sup>; House Shirts in on September 20<sup>th</sup>, going home the 21<sup>st</sup>.
- Silent Auction: The sign-up sheet has been put out for each teacher to choose their topic and then things will be collected by parents.
- Working on October newsletter.

# **Principal's Report**

Principal Houghton gave the principal's report.

- Have Hispanic Heritage month starting today (September 15). Last year did door decorating contest, will be doing it again. Doors will be decorated from September 26 to October 14, with judging on October 10. Teachers can decide which Hispanic figure to celebrate, and teachers will be doing something each week.
- Freedom week last week of September, will do a red, white, and blue day on September 28, will give out red, white and blue popsicles. Houghton gave the history and purpose of the event.
- ADDitions sign-up: Encouraging teachers to take students on at least two field trips, so parents who want to
  chaperone need to sign-up now so they can go as they must be approved. A process has been set-up to be
