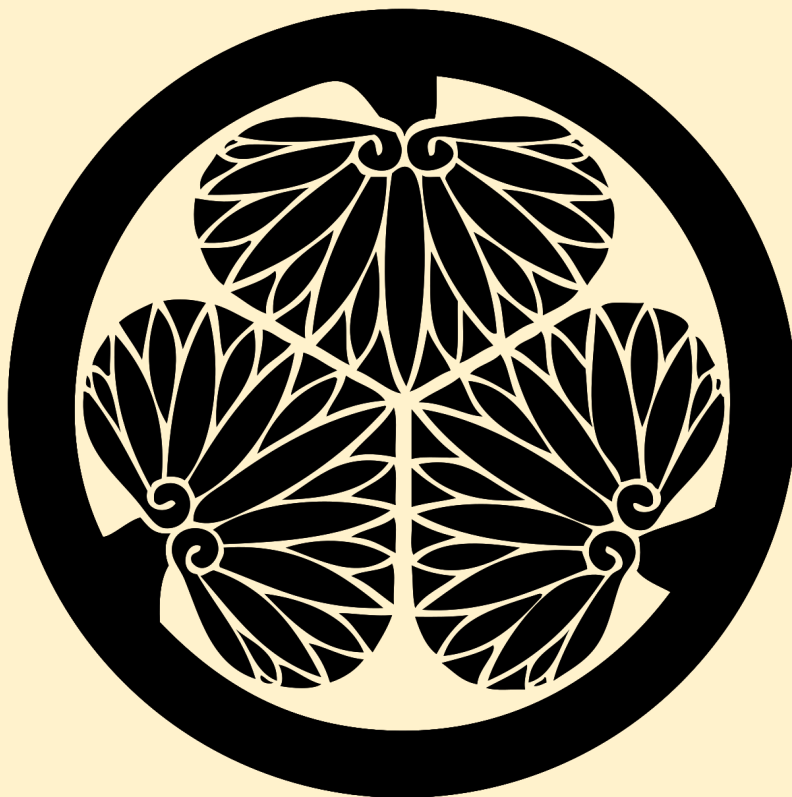

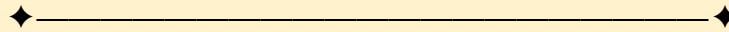

❖ *Medal of Bushido* ❖



Takeshidō no kunshō is awarded to warriors who have proved their combat prowess and discipline on the battlefield, (Considered from 28/03/2022 and after)

It has four classes:

Seido no Takeshidō no kunshō - Kill 40+ people in one battle.

Gin no Takeshidō no kunshō - Kill 60+ people in one battle.

Kin no Takeshidō no kunshō - Kill 80+ people in one battle.

Kōseki no Takeshidō no kunshō - Kill 100+ people in one battle. (Only awarded by Tenno, Shogun & Daimyo. Considered since the inception of Tokugawa Bakufu.)

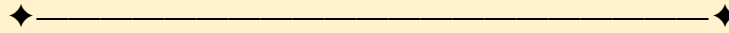




❖ GUN'EKI NO KUNSHŌ ❖

❖ 軍役の勲章 ❖

❖ *Service Medal* ❖



Gun'eiki no Kunsho is awarded for long service to the Shogunate.
(Considered since the inception of Tokugawa Bakufu.)

It has four classes:

Seido no Gun'eiki no Kunshō - Serve 3 months.

Gin no Gun'eiki no Kunshō - Serve 6 months.

Kin no Gun'eiki no Kunshō - Serve 9 months.

Kōseki no Gun'eiki no Kunshō - Serve for 1 year. (Only awarded by Tenno, Shogun & Daimyo. Considered since the inception of Tokugawa Bakufu.)

Eien chūsei no kunshō is awarded to distinguishably loyal members of the Tokugawa who place priority for us. (Only awarded by Tenno, Shogun & Daimyo. Considered since the inception of Tokugawa Bakufu.)

The Chūsei no Kunshō is a lower grade of the *Eien chūsei no kunshō* that is awarded to members of the group who bring minor yet notable efforts and contributions to the group. This medal can be awarded by clan staff.

Saiyō no Kunshō is awarded for recruiting multiple people into Tokugawa.
(Only awarded by Tenno, Shogun & Daimyo. Considered since the inception of Tokugawa Bakufu.)

Jihi no Kunsho is awarded to people who pay generous donations (via the group store) or do important services towards the group. (Only awarded by Tenno, Shogun & Daimyo. Considered since the inception of Tokugawa Bakufu.)

Yūki no kunshō is awarded to the fearless line commanders of Tokugawa Bakufu for showing valor, courage, honor on the battlefield (Only awarded by Tenno, Shogun & Daimyo. Considered since the inception of Tokugawa Bakufu.)

Hattatsu no kunshō is awarded to developers for important works in the group. (Only awarded by Tenno, Shogun & Daimyo. Considered since the inception of Tokugawa Bakufu.)

Kinshi no kunshō shall be bestowed upon all the warriors who fought in the great Grand Battle of Waterloo & Wavre for Japan, held on 9th of July 2022. (Only awarded by Tenno, Shogun & Daimyo. Considered since the inception of Tokugawa Bakufu.)

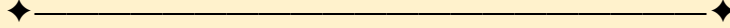




❖ GIYUU NO KUNSHŌ ❖

❖ *Medal of Heroism* ❖

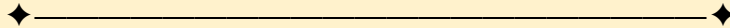


*The **Giyuu no Kunshō*** is awarded to the individual who performs an exceptional act of heroism, valor, and bravery. Their actions have either turned the tide of battle in our favor, or caused the complete destruction of the enemy. They are the paragon of what every soldier should aim to be.

*The **Aka no Jushō*** is awarded to the individual who performs an act of heroism, whether it be saving an allied flag or causing the capture of the enemy flag, they had the skill and courage to make an impact on the battle. This is the lesser form of the *Giyuu no Kunshō*

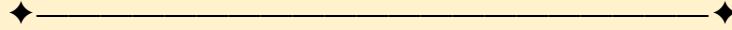




❖ JUDŌ NO KUNSHŌ ❖

The Judō no Jushō is awarded to the individual who acts independently of the commander and achieves a beneficial outcome for the line or battle, or a staff member who takes control, if a commander is suddenly out-of-action, and proceeds to bring victory to battle in their place.

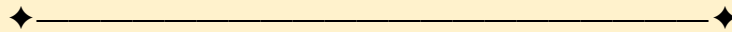


The Gin no Jushō is awarded to the commander of a line for performing a brave and valiant act beyond the expected abilities of said person or their unit. (Tier 1 of the Strategy Medal series)

The Gin no Jushō is awarded to the commander of a line who performs a great act of gallantry and prowess in the face of the enemy. (Tier 2 of the Strategy Medal series)

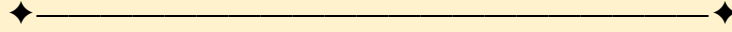




❖ YUUKI NO KUNSHŌ ❖

The Yuuki no Jushō is awarded to a fearless line commander, who shows bravery, daring and dauntlessness, when faced with insurmountable odds. They succeed in beating the odds and achieve a significant triumph for their team. (Tier 3 of the Strategy Medal series)
