All children will run in year groups. This is in line with the Canterbury Cross Country as it is 'year at school' grouping for 2018. All children will need to have name tags with their name, year and school. Schools are welcome to bring all year levels to the cross country.

Distances:

Short Course – Year 1 and 2

1.5 Km – Years 3 and 4

2 Km – Year 5 and 6

3 Km – Year 7 and 8

Assembly:

All children will be at the course for a 12.30pm start.

Programme

Race 1 – Year 1 and 2

Race 2 – Year 3 and 4

Race 3 – Year 5 and 6

Race 4 - Year 7 and 8

We will be running each race with a gap in-between each race. Senior children will be selected to run with junior children.

Courses:

Schools will be provided with a map of the course. The course for all the children will be the same as last year.

Kowai Cross Country:

The top place getters in each year level (Year 5 to 8) will be running at the Kowai Cross Country.

Marshalls:

Parents are needed for marshaling, 4 from Broomfield, 2 from Waipara and 2 from Omihi. Schools to supply marshals with fluorescent vests. Marshalls to report to the time recorders desk at 12.25pm.

First Aid:

Organised by Broomfield: St John

Starting Marshalls:

Call up competitors, over the loudspeaker, just prior to their event.

Starter:

“ Take your marks – set – BANG!” Starter also to start the stopwatch for each race. Take the stop watch to the recording desk as soon as the children have started the race. Inform the recorders of which race the stop watch is for.

Recorder:

Take name tags and place them on the sheets provided. Record the children’s finish time next to their name.

Certificates:

Will be presented by schools. Certificates will be for placing and participation. – Broomfield Principal

Finish line marshals:

Ensure children stay in the right order. Directing them to the recorders table.

Spectator Duty:

Schools to be responsible for behaviour of children waiting while races are being run and ensuring that the children are marshaled into the correct race. Children are to be inside their school’s allocated area while races are being run. Bins will be available, please ensure your area is tidy before you leave.

Course Marshalls:

Take given position on course to direct runners ect. At the conclusion of the event, please **leave** all cones so they are in place for the Kowai Cross Country. Marshalls will be required to have the starters (Andrew Kemps) phone number to ensure that if there are any accidents he is notified: Phone: 027 315 1620.
