Billings unfortunately missed 13 Games this season, and averaged 6.5 Minutes less per game than last season.

149 Points (6.5)

Billings shot 47% this past season and had 4 games where she earned 10+ Points, but did in 2 of her last 4 including a season high 15 Points against the Liberty in the finale but 2/18 to start the season. To end the 2021 season she finished with 10+ Points in 10/12 including 5 games with 14+ Points

146 Rebounds (6.3)

The per game stats don't show the impact Monique had on the glass this season, per 40 minutes she finished 4th in the W in Offensive Rebounds (behind only Engstler, Milic, and McCowan, 4th in Defensive Rebounds (behind only Wilson, Fowles, and Candace Parker), and 2nd in Total Rebounds behind Teaira McCowan. I believe she deserved more minutes at the beginning of the season especially and if she chooses to re-sign in Atlanta is given at least 20 minutes per game. She earned 6 or more Rebounds in 5 of her last 6 games this season, including 9 in 15 Minutes against the Liberty on 8/12. She earned 8 Games of at least 8 Rebounds and a season high 14 in the opener against the Wings. This was her 5th season in a row finishing in the Top 10 in offensive rebounds per 40 minutes, she is the only player on this category. She earned 8 Games of 3 or more a season high 5 in the opener and 7 in her final 2 games

26 Assists (1.1) Assists

3rd season in a row averaging at least an Assist/GM. Had back to back games of 4 Assists on 7/3 against the Storm and 7/6 against the Mystics. She ended the season with at least 2 Assists in 5 of her last 6 Games

19 Steals (.8)

Lowest per game total since 2019, but again another stat that's distorted by drop in minutes. Her per 40 minute stats have below last seasons 2 per 40 minutes, as she averaged 1.9 this season. Her best stretch was 10 Steals in 5 games from 6/26-7/6 including 3 against the Liberty on 6/30

8 Blocks (.3)

This is stat which was lower both per game and per 40 minutes as she had 8 total Blocks the entire season, she earned 32 last season.

Overall the hustle and energy Billings brings is worth keeping on the roster if she wants to re-sign in Atlanta. This will be her first season being an UFA

Hard to believe Maya only played in 9 games for the Dream this season with the impact she made, including receiving 7 starts

98 Points (10.9)

Maya made an impact from the get-go, as she earned 18 Points in her WNBA debut against the Wings on 6/21 in 30 minutes. Her last 2 games of her first stint she only received 33 minutes and gained 8 Points

In her 2nd stint, she earned at 9 Points in each of her 6 games including 17 Points against the Aces off of 7/9 shooting and the controversial 14 Points against the Liberty in the season finale off of 5-7 shooting where she mysteriously didn't play in the 2nd half. In total she averaged 12 Points in those 6 Games

18 3PM (2.0)

Maya Caldwell had the 2nd highest 3pt% in WNBA history with a minimum of 30 attempts, as she shot 18-32 beyond the arc, which is an 56.3% clip. In her first game

against the Wings and her last game against the Liberty, she went 4-5. She made at least two 3PM in 5 of her last 6 games

22 Rebounds (2.4)

Maya showed she is going to be a player that makes an impact on every layer of the stat sheet, including Rebounding where she earned 7 against the Fever on 8/3.

20 Assists (2.2)

After surrendering 5 Turnovers in her first game, Maya never had a game with more than 2. She earned 6 Assists with only 1 Turnover against the Fever on 8/3 and had at least 1 Assist in each of her 9 Games

7 Steals (.8)

Another stat figure where she had her best games statistically in both her first and last game, as she 2 Steals against both the Wings and Liberty.

2 Blocks (.2)

Maya earned 2 Blocks, one against the Fever on 8/3, and the other against the Lynx on 8/7

The offense was sporadic at times for Coffey, but she earned 5 Games with double-digit points including a season high 16 Points against the Fever on 6/5. She has now gone back to back season with 6.4 or more Points for the first time in her career

9 3PM (.6)

After averaging 1.6 3PM last season with the Sparks at a 41.7% clip, Coffey only shot 29% averaging .6 3PM/GM in 2022. I really think things would've taken a positive turn if she had been able to play the remainder of the season after returning against the Sky on 7/12, as she went 3-6 beyond the arc in her finale

83 Rebounds (5.2)

Coffey shattered her previous career high of 3.8 Rebounds per game last season with 5.2/GM in 2022. She earned 2 Double-Double's, an 12 Point, 10 Rebound effort against the Mystics on 5/20 and an 16 Point, 10 Rebound effort against the Fever on 6/5

12 Assists (.8)

Coffey for the 3rd straight season averaged at least .8 Assists, but had a career high 2.2 Turnovers when in her previous 5 seasons she had never averaged above 1.4. She had a season high 3 Assists against the Mercury on 5/29

10 Steals (.6)

She was right above her career average of .5 per game, and had her best stretch 6/7-6/10 with 2 steals in each game against the Mercury and Storm

2 Blocks (.1)

After averaging over a Block per game in 2021 at 1.2, she only had 2 Blocks total this season. On 5/7 against the Wings and 5/20 against the Mystics

Depending on how the offseason goes, I'd like Atlanta to give Coffey another chance. If she can continue efficiency on the boards with a consistent jump shot she'd be someone great to have off the bench or potentially in starting lineup

Unfortunately due to injuries that occurred late in her season overseas and towards the end of the Dream season, we received limited action of Tip. There was also the controversial missing of the final 2 games against Liberty, instead of playing in an international 3X3 tournament instead of fighting with the Dream to make the playoffs. Why didn't the Dream do hardship exemption while she was overseas? Could've used player until Tips return on 6/30...20 games into the season

178 Points (14.8)

This was Tip's 3rd consecutive season of averaging between 14.7-14.8 Points. She earned double-digit Points in each contest except for her final game against the Wings on 7/30 where she got injured. Her season high was 31 Points in our best victory of the season over the Aces, she also dropped 24 against the Lynx on 7/28

18 3PM (1.5)

Tip earned 2 games of 4 3PM in her season debut in a victory over the Liberty off of 4-6 shooting and on 7/19 against the Aces where she went 4-5 beyond the arc and 11-14 overall from the floor. She earned at least 1 3PM in 8/12 shooting a career high 42.9% on 3's beating last seasons career high of 40.5%

40 Rebounds (3.3)

Tip's 3.3 Rebounds per game was her best since 2018 where she averaged 3.6. From 7/12-7/28 (8 Games) Tip earned at least 3 Rebounds. She earned a season high 8 boards against the Sky on 7/12 to begin a 3 game streak of 6 or more Rebounds

23 Assists (1.9)

This was Tip's first season averaging less than 2 Assists since her Sophomore season in 2013. She did earn at least 1 Assist in each game and earned her best performance against the Mercury on 7/17 with 6 Assists and 0 Turnovers. After surrendering at least 3 Turnovers in 4 consecutive games from 7/3-7/15, Tip didn't commit more than 2 in the remainder of her games.

8 Steals (.7)

This was Tip's lowest average of her 10 season tenure with the Dream and it was the first time since her Rookie season in 2012 averaging less than 1 Steal per game. She earned 1 Steal in 8/12, and have no doubt she would've averaged more playing in more games

1 Block (.1)

If we had gotten 30 Games

(2nd) 444 Points

Would've been 2nd on the team in Points averaging the same 16.2 per game as Rhyne Howard. Absolutely the difference between missing the playoffs and securely being in with having 2 legitimate threats throughout the season. Before the season I was hoping for her to be Robin to Rhyne like she was for Angel.

45 3PM

Her 3PM per game of 1.6 was 3rd on the team behind Maya Caldwell and Rhyne Howard

I'll go over this more at the end of this episode and throughout the offseason, but I think it's time for the Dream to have a changing of the Guard after 10 seasons. Tip only signed a 1 year deal with Atlanta last offseason. With AD and Kristy Wallace most likely back in the fold along with 3 Top 15 draft picks and hopefully re-signing Maya Caldwell it's time for Atlanta and Hayes to take a new direction

Naz had a completely healthy Rookie campaign with only not participating in 2 Games due to Coach Wright lineup decisions. I knew she was the steal of the draft when we got her at 15 and she exceeded my expectations for her Rookie season. From 7/15-8/5 she played at least 30 Minutes.

150 Points (4.4)

Naz's offense game in spurts, but she definitely showed she has the skill set to succeed in the W, especially as she gains more confidence in her jump shot. She earned 11 Games with at least 7 Points including 4 Games with 10+ Points. She earned a season high 13 Points against the Sun on 7/15 and earned back to back games of 10 Points 8/7-8/9

172 Rebounds (5.1)

From 6/15-8/14 (23 Games) Naz was Atlanta's leading rebounder at 6.4 per game and 2nd in Total Rebounds. She earned 3 double digit rebounding performances including a season high 14 on 7/24 against the Seattle Storm. She earned her first career Double-Double against the Sun on 7/15 with 13 Points and 11 Rebounds

41 Assists (1.2)

Naz earned at least 2 Assists in 14 games this season including in each of her final 4 Games. In a 4 game stretch from 7/17-7/24 she earned 11 Assists and a season high 4 Assists against the Storm on 7/24. Overall she averaged the same amount of Assists as Turnovers at 1.2 per game

22 Steals (.6)

From 6/24 until the end of the season (20 Games) Naz Hillmon averaged a Steal per game tied for 3rd best on the team behind only Aari McDonald and Rhyne Howard. In 11 of her last 13 Games she earned at least 1 Steal including 6 consecutive games from 7/28-8/9. She earned a season high 3 Steals against the Liberty on 6/24

10 Blocks (.3)

Naz's best Block stretch came between 7/17-7/24 where she amassed 5 Blocks in 4 Games including 2 against the Aces on 7/19 and against the Storm on 7/24

Overall Naz had an immensely successful season. She held her ground and wasn't intimidated no matter who she was guarding and was a force on the glass. Cannot wait to see what's in store for her Sophomore campaign

Rhyne exceeded every preseason projection from me except for Rebounding. What we witnessed this season was the beginning of a generational player's career and I'm going to try and enjoy every moment. Absolute superstar and if MVP was an award for most valuable to their team, Rhyne wins in a landslide.

(1st) 552 Points (16.2)

Rhyne earned at least 10 Points in 30/34 games and 11 games of 20+ Points including a season high 33 Points against the Fever on 5/15. She ended the season scoring at least 18 Points in 7 of her last 11 Games. If she had an consistent scoring threat alongside her throughout the season, she would've done even more. It's absolutely phenomenal what she accomplished this season. The end of the season showed the Rhyne we should have in 2023, a legitimate MVP threat with a lethal jump shot and the ability to score inside. After only earning 6+ FTA twice in 27 Games (2.6/GM) Rhyne earned at least 6 attempts in 6 of her last 7 Games (7.7/GM) closest in this time span was Tierra McCowan at 6.8. Over this span she was 4th in Points (19.7), 2nd in 3PM (3.0), and 4th in Steals (2.0)

(1st) 85 3PM (2.5) Rhyne now already owns the most 3PM and largest per game average 3PM in Atlanta Dream franchise history. She shot 34.3% overall with 9 Games of at least 4 3PM including 6 makes against the Mercury on 6/10. She finished tied for 4th in the WNBA overall behind only Arike, Taurasi, and Kelsey Plum. She had a

ridiculous 16 games where she made 3 or more shots beyond the arc including 3 consecutive games from 5/15-5/20

(3rd) 154 Rebounds (4.5)

This is a stat category I expect a significant jump in for 2023 when Rhyne isn't as targeted as long as the Dream have another consistent scoring threat. She earned 8 Games of at least 6 Rebounds including back to back 8 board performances 6/21 against the Wings and 6/24 against the Liberty. Her best Rebounding game was 9 on 7/21 against the Sparks where she also earned 5 Offensive boards.

(2nd) 96 Assists (2.8)

Another category where I believe there will be a significant jump in as Rhyne is an underrated passer. She earned 8 games with at least 4 Assists including two 7 Assist performances, the best being the season finale against the Liberty where she had 7 Assists without committing a single turnover. She surrendered a turnover or less in 20/34 games. In August she had 23 Assists with only 9 Turnovers in 6 Games

(1st) 54 Steals (1.6)

As mentioned earlier she ended the season 4th in Steals over her last 7 games of the season. On 8/3 against the Fever she swiped 5 Steals and earned at least 2 Steals in half of her 34 Games. She finished tied for 4th in the WNBA behind only Nneka Ogumike, Alyssa Thomas, and Brittany Sykes.

(2nd) 26 Blocks (.8)

Rhyne earned 18 Games of at least 1 Block 5 Games of 2+ Blocks. In her WNBA debut against the Dallas Wings she earned a season high 4. Most of them were thrilling with authority and momentum changing events where especially in Atlanta it electrified the crowd. From June 7th-June 26th, a span of 7 games she earned at least 1 Block.

I'll go over a massive list of accomplishments and records she achieved in a later episode, but I'll end with stating she ended the season with the 2nd longest consecutive game streak in WNBA history of at least 10 Points, 1 3PM, 2 Rebounds, 1 Assist, and 1 Steal as she's at 11 consecutive games. If she earns it again in the season opener, she'll tie Tamika Catchings for the longest streak ever

Aari was one of 3 players on the Dream to play in all 36 games. She went up from averaging 16.4 Minutes in 2021 to 24.3 in 2022. She was a spark plug off the bench both offensively and defensively

398 Points (11.1)

Exceeded my preseason expectations and specifically saw massive improvements in her 2 Point shooting game where she went from 34.3% shooting in 2021 to 46.9% in 2022. She earned 23 double digit point scoring outings including in her last 7 Games. Her best stretch was 6 games from 6/10-6/26 where she averaged 16 Points and shot 47.8% from the floor. She had 2 20 Point outings on 5/13 against the Aces and 6/17 against the Sky

48 3PM (1.3)

Aari improved 30.8% shooting beyond the arc to 33.8% this season. Efficiency went up and down, but earned 7 games of 3+ 3PM including a 5-7 performance against the Aces on 5/13. She finished the season 1-9 including 0-4 in the season finale.

81 Rebounds (2.3)

Her Rebound production more than doubled from 1.6 to 2.3 in 2022. She earned 6 games of 5 or more Rebounds with a season high 8 on 5/29 against the Phoenix Mercury.

93 Assists (2.6)

This was the category where she fell short of my expectations and will be looking for more consistency in 2023. I think there's especially potential when she's using her speed to drive to the hoop and it attracts defenders to the paint. In her Rookie season

she was 16th in Assists per 40 minutes among players who played in at least 30 games she dropped to 38th in 2022. She earned 11 Games of 4+ Assists including 2 6 Assist outings on 6/17 against the Sky and 8/3 against the Fever. However, she also had 8 Games of 4+ Turnovers

53 Steals (1.5)

Something that absolutely carried over from last season was Aari's energy and tenacity on defense as she finished 11th in Steals and 4th per 40 Minutes behind only Veronica Burton, Rebekah Gardner, and Brittany Sykes. She earned 15 games with 2+ Steals including a career high 7 against the Minnesota Lynx on June 1st. She went 12 consecutive games with swiping at least 1 Steal from from May 5th through June 21st where she led the entire WNBA during this span averaging 2.3 Steals per Game and 27 total

Overall she has a lot of potential. Again would like to see her evolve as more of a playmaker to earn a starting role along with her consistent scoring and energy on the defensive end

One thing Beatrice was extremely efficient in, was Rebounds. She earned 11 games with at least 3 with a season high 8 against the Liberty. Players that played at least 20 games, Mompremier was 4th per 40 minutes in Rebounds behind only Sylvia Fowles, Monique Billings and Tierra McCowan

8 Assists (.4)

Mompremier had a season high 2 Assists with no turnovers against Sparks on 6/21

2 Steals (.1)

Both of Monpremier's Steals were against the Sun in games on 6/15 and 6/26

12 Blocks (.6)

Earned 3 Games with 2 Blocks, all of these against the Sun: 6/15, 6/26, and 7/15. She had a Block in 4 consecutive games 7/28-8/5 (Lynx, Wings, Fever, Sparks) Became 3rd player in Atlanta Dream history to earn 3 consecutive games of at least 2 Blocks against the Sun joining Elizabeth Williams (2X) and Angel McCoughtry. Cheyenne Parker played in all 36 Dream games her first season playing 30+ games since 2019 with the Chicago Sky. She had 35 starts, shattering her previous high of 13 with the Sky in 2020

426 Points (11.8)

In my preseason player projections, I stated Cheyenne would shatter my PPG prediction with a steady 3 Ball. She instead earned the majority of them through an elite inside game. She shot 55.2% from 2-Point range which was her 2nd best of her career only bested by 2020. Cheyenne earned 25 Games with 10+ Points, 9 Games with 15+ Points, and 3 Games with 20+ Points including 21 Point outings against Seattle on 7/3 and against Phoenix on 7/17 where she shot 10-13 from the floor (77%). Cheyenne was also the team leader in clutch points (points scored where game is within 5 Points with 5 or less Minutes left) with 31 Points while shooting 56.5% from the floor. She ended the season with double digit points in 10 of 12, including 9 consecutive games from 6/21-8/12. Overall she was 2nd on the Dream in Points.

12 3PM (.3)

Beyond the arc Cheyenne only shot 21.8%, her lowest of her career with at least .5 attempts per game after averaging close to a make per game last season and shooting 33.3%. She earned 3 Games of 2 3PM: 5/11 vs the Sparks, 6/10 against the Mercury, and 6/21 against the Wings. From 6/24 until the end of the season, a 20 game span, she only made 3 3-Pointers, going 3-22 for 13%. If she goes back to shooting at least 30% clip, she's a no brainer All-Star for 2023 with the inside moves she displayed this season

222 Rebounds (6.2)

Cheyenne was the Dream's leader in Total Rebounds, as she gobbled up at least 5 Rebounds in 27 Games including 11 of her last 12 games to end the season. She earned 5 games with 10+ Rebounds, all of them resulting in Double-Doubles: her best performance being the previously mentioned where she earned a season high 21 Points along with a season high 12 Rebounds against the Mercury. She earned back to back Double-Doubles on 6/7 against the Storm and 6/10 against the Mercury. Her 222 Rebounds was the first time exceeding 200 Rebounds in a single season and her 2nd best per game mark behind only her 2020 Wubble season with the Sky

71 Assists (2.0)

The 2022 season was by far Cheyenne's most successful season in the passing game, as she averaged a career high 2 Assists per game. She earned 12 Games with at least 3 Assists and 3 Games with 5 Assists, including back to back outings on 8/7 against the Lynx and a 5 Assist and only 1 Turnover gem against the Aces on 8/9. From

7/19-8/12 (10 Games) she was averaging 3 Assists per Game. Her next development will be lowering her Turnovers as had 12 games where she surrendered 3 or more including 2 outings with 5. From 6/1-6/21 (8 Games) she went without committing more than 2 Turnovers, averaging 1.6 Assists to 1.1 Turnovers.

37 Steals (1.0)

This was Parker's 3rd consecutive season of averaging at least a Steal per game, she earned 12 games with multiple Steals, including a season high 4 against the Sky on 6/17.

32 Blocks (.9)

This was Cheyenne's 5th season in a row averaging at least .9 Blocks. She earned 8 Games with multiple Blocks including a season high 4 on 5/13 against the Aces and 6/17 against the Sky. From 5/7-6/24 she averaged 1.4 Blocks per game over 17 Games which was 5th in the WNBA behind only Egbo, Cambage, Wilson, and Magbegor. Over the last 19 games she only averaged .5 Blocks.

Overall a highly successful campaign for Cheyenne Parker and I'm again extremely bullish on her having an All-Star campaign in 2023 with the Dream most likely fielding a more competitive roster to support her. She will play overseas in Italy over the WNBA offseason

73 Points (2.5)

With the limited minutes, she saw lows dating back to her first couple seasons in the league, so going to focus on her production instead. Her best point span was in a 11 game stretch from 6/3-7/17 where she earned 4 games of 5+ Points, including tying for a season high 8 Points on 6/30 against her 1st W team in the Liberty spanning 6 seasons, her other 8 Point night was against the Fever on 8/3

93 Rebounds (3.2)

From a per 40 minutes perspective, Kia Vaughn's 3 offensive Rebound and 9.3 Total Rebound average was her best since 2017. She earned two games of 9 Rebounds, both outings taking place against former teams she was a part of: 6/30 against the Liberty and 7/17 against the Mercury, where 7 of her 9 rebounds were on the offensive glass. She was only the 2nd player in WNBA history to accomplish this feat over the age of 35. In her final 5 games, she earned 21 Total Rebounds with at least 3 in each contest.

25 Assists (.9)

From a per 40 minutes perspective, her 2.5 average was the 3rd best season of her career with the previous taking place with the Mercury in 2020 and 2021. Her best stretch was 6/1-6/5, where she earned 7 Assists in 3 Games, including a season high on 6/1 against the Lynx. From 7/12-8/9 she earned at least 1 Assist in 11/12 games

10 Steals (.3)

Vaughn hasn't been known for her Steals, as she only earned 1 season averaging over 1 which was in 2011. From 7/28-7/30 she earned 2 consecutive games with at least 1 Steal and a season high 2 against the Lynx on 6/28.

8 Blocks (.3)

Vaughn's 8 Blocks were her most since 2017. She earned a season high 3 Blocks against the Fever on 5/15 which was her 12th time in her career earning 3+ Blocks in a single game and her first since 2016. She also earned consecutive games with a Block: 1 against the Lynx on 6/1 and 2 against the Sky on 6/3
