Key Parent Tools

ParentSquare (Communication)

This is our primary district-wide communication tool. It is used to send announcements, messages, and to facilitate parent-teacher conference sign-ups. You can access it via the web portal or by downloading the ParentSquare app from the App Store or Google Play. Update contact information for ParentSquare in Campus Parent/Parent Portal.

Campus Parent/Parent Portal (Academic Information)

The Parent Portal is where you can access your child's academic information from Infinite Campus including:

- Report cards
- Student schedules and attendance records
- Assessment and immunization records
- Contact information updates
- Transportation information

You can download the Campus Parent app or access the portal on the web.

Student Learning Platforms

Google Classroom

Google Classroom is a learning management system used by teachers to streamline teaching, assignments, and communication for teachers and students.

ClassLink

ClassLink is a single sign-on platform that gives students easy access to all of their digital learning resources using their school credentials or a QuickCard.

MagicSchool

MagicSchool is an educator-built Artificial Intelligence (AI) platform to help make learning more fun and personalized for your child. Teachers will use MagicSchool to create engaging, personalized lessons and provide more individualized support for your child. Teachers will guide students on what information is safe to share and how to review responses for accuracy and validity, emphasizing important Digital Citizenship ideals.

Coding with Codesters on Learning.com (Grade 5)

Every fifth grade student will participate in a 33-week coding program using Codesters on Learning.com. The program will be facilitated by our Technology Integration Coaches and will provide an introduction to coding that will bridge into the sixth grade Python curriculum.

Technology Devices and Support

Chromebooks

Each student is assigned a District provided Chromebook. Student Chromebooks will travel with students to the next grade level. A Chromebook charger has been provided to students to keep at home.
