FGoI (Fake Govt. Of India), FGoT (Fake Govt. of Telangana) are proven twin cybercriminal organizations, owing to the 2 FIRs, (i) s0053/2014@KPHB PS (ii) 0006/2018@Cybercrimes PS, by the Cyberabad police@Telangana. They are the first CCOs of the kind-of online fake governments in India. They came to be in vogue in the second decade of the current millennium. FGoIFGoT involve big data cybercrimes of degree 1,20,000 units of multifarious, India-abusive cybercrimes. Nearly 2500 online registrants of multifarious academic streams were cybercriminally influenced under the sway of the FGoIFGoT.
