Endnotes

¹ Became the de facto QP when the previous senior apostle, Thomas B. Marsh, was excommunicated for apostasy. He was officially set apart as QP on April 14, 1840.

² From 1847 to 1868, Hyde was the third most senior apostle. The second most senior apostle was Heber C. Kimball, a member of the First Presidency. If the current practice had been followed, Kimball would have been Quorum's president, and Hyde would have served as acting president. However, Kimball was never called as such. Note that Hyde's tenure ended due to a ruling by President Brigham Young that the most senior apostle who had served consistently should serve as the Quorum President. Hyde had been previously disfellowshipped for brief periods in 1839 and 1846.

³ Became QP when Brigham Young adjusted apostolic seniority in 1875. See note on Orson Hyde above. He was not formally set apart as QP until after Brigham Young's death. That took place on October 6, 1877.

⁴ Whether or not Woodruff was ever sustained as QP is unclear.

⁵ Not officially sustained or set apart as QP until 17 October 1901, when Joseph F. Smith became Church President. At the beginning of Young's tenure, George Q. Cannon was the second most senior Apostle in the Church. However, Cannon was a counselor in the First Presidency and never served as President of the Quorum. (If today's practices had been followed, Cannon would have been the QP and Young the Acting QP.) When Cannon died in April 1901, Young remained the Quorum's President, although First Presidency member Joseph F. Smith was then the second most senior Apostle. See Orson Hyde's 1847 to 1868 tenure above for a similar anomaly. Young also served as QP between 17 October 1901 and 11 April 1903.

⁶ It is unclear if Smith was ever sustained or set apart as Quorum President since his tenure lasted only one week between the death of Lorenzo Snow and Smith's ordination as his successor.

⁷ Not officially sustained or set apart as QP until October 6, 1903.

⁸ Since Lund served in the First Presidency as QP, Rudger Clawson served as Acting President.

⁹ Since McKay was serving in the First Presidency during his entire tenure as QP, Joseph Fielding Smith served as Acting President.

¹⁰ During Smith's tenure as QP, he served from October 29, 1965-January 23, 1970 as an additional counselor in the First Presidency; however, in this unique situation, he was still actively serving as both the QP and a quorum member.

¹¹ During his tenure as QP, Lee served in the First Presidency. Spencer W. Kimball was the Acting President of the Quorum during this time.

¹² As President Romney was not in good health during his tenure, President Howard W. Hunter was Acting President of the Quorum.

¹³ Became the de facto QP upon the death of President Romney but wasn't officially set apart in that position until June 2.

¹⁴ Since President Gordon B. Hinckley, the QP, and President Thomas S. Monson, the next most senior apostle, served in the First Presidency during Hinckley's entire tenure, President Boyd K. Packer served as Acting President of the Quorum.

¹⁵ As President Thomas S. Monson, the QP, served in the First Presidency during his entire tenure, President Boyd K. Packer served as Acting President of the Quorum.

¹⁶ Upon the death of President Boyd K. Packer on July 3, 2015, Russell M. Nelson became the de facto QP. He was officially set apart in that position on July 15, 2015.

¹⁷ Because Quorum President Dallin H. Oaks is serving in the First Presidency, M. Russell Ballard was, and Jeffrey R. Holland is serving as the Acting President.

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Endnotes

¹ While this First Presidency continued to serve together for a time after this, additional counselors were called to assist them on the end date noted here.

² While this First Presidency continued to serve together for roughly a year after this, on the end date noted above, Gordon B. Hinckley was called as an additional counselor in the First Presidency on the end date noted above.

³ Some sources from which I obtained this information list the third-longest Quorum of the Twelve as it was constituted between July 3, 1870-November 28, 1878. I have a problem with doing so because the apostles in that Quorum of the Twelve Apostles only actually served together until April 8, 1873, at which point three members (George Q. Cannon, Brigham Young Jr., and Albert Carrington) left the Quorum to serve as additional counselors to Brigham Young.

⁴ While some sources available to me list April 6, 1896, as the end date for this group, that was merely the date on which a member of the First Presidency passed away: there was no actual change to the Quorum membership until July 19, when Church members opposed Moses Thatcher continuing in the Quorum because he failed to comply with the Manifesto and give up polygamy.

⁵ The Quorum of the Twelve listed here has only 11 members since Parley P. Pratt was assassinated on the date when this period began. George Q. Cannon was called to fill the apostolic vacancy on the end date listed for this group's tenure.

⁶ Some sources from which I pulled this data list the start of these tenure lengths as the date on which the junior member of the Quorum of the Twelve Apostles was ordained to the apostleship. However, I determined that the relevant data should be when those junior apostles were sustained since they were recognized by the Church as Quorum members for almost a week before their apostolic ordinations.

⁷ Daniel H. Wells and John Willard Young were ordained apostles at Brigham Young's discretion. Both also served as Brigham Young's counselors.

⁸ Some sources incorrectly identify the end of this period as July 3, 2015 (at which time Boyd K. Packer passed away), but they fail to take the May 30, 2015 death of L. Tom Perry into account, which is why the end date is earlier here than it is in those sources.

⁹ Charles W. Nibley was never ordained as an apostle.

¹⁰ Many sources use October 6, 1988, as the start date for this group's tenure, but that was the date of Richard G. Scott's ordination to the apostleship. The sustaining vote that brought him into the Quorum of the Twelve Apostles was held 5 days earlier. Therefore, that is the date I am opting to use.

¹¹ Some sources incorrectly identify the end date of the tenure of this group of apostles as July 1, 1866 (which was the date on which Joseph F. Smith was ordained as an apostle). But on February 4, 1864, Brigham Young Jr. and Joseph Angell Young were ordained apostles. While they were not called to serve in the First Presidency or Quorum of the Twelve on that date, since they were ordained as apostles, it seemed more appropriate for me to list the earlier date.

¹² While there were technically no changes in the First Presidency or Quorum of the Twelve until May 16, 1925, since John Willard Young (an ordained apostle who was not a member of either the First Presidency or the Quorum of the Twelve Apostles) passed away on February 12, 1924,

according to the information I track, I consider Elder Young's death to have ended the tenure of this group of apostles.

¹³ No sources that I used to compile this information listed this group of apostles, but since I have 14 groups apiece of the longest continuously-serving First Presidencies and Quorums of the Twelve Apostles, I have considered it worthwhile to add this group as the 13th longest continuously-serving group of all ordained apostles.

¹⁴ The beginning date noted here is when Elders Dieter F. Uchtdorf and David A. Bednar were sustained to fill the vacancies in the Quorum of the Twelve Apostles. Their official ordinations to the apostleship occurred 5 days later, but the date they joined the Quorum is the more pertinent information.
