

BHS FBLA Graduation Honor Cord Requirements



<u>Purpose</u>: To recognize outstanding FBLA graduates, as well as, to promote leadership and service-learning amongst BHS students.

You must be a nationally affiliated member of FBLA for a minimum of <u>2 years</u> AND earn <u>120</u> **points** by the end of the Senior year to earn an FBLA Honor Cord to be worn at graduation.

Points awarded come from the list below:

- 1. Chapter Attendance: 5 points for each chapter meeting or social event attended
- 2. Affiliated Membership: 7 points for each year of paid FBLA Membership dues
- 3. Chapter Leadership: 20 points for each year of being a dedicated and active officer
- 4. Conferences Attendance:
 - 10 points for attending Fall Leadership Conference Athens
 - 7 points for attending Region Leadership Conference/Competition Collins Hill
 - 15 points for attending State Leadership Conference/Competition Atlanta
- 5. Competitions
 - 10 points per Objective Test
 - 10 points per Role Play Event
 - 20 points per Performance Event
- 6. Service Hours/Donations
 - o 1-5 points service hours/donations to be determined by chapter adviser
- 7. Fundraising
 - 10 points for each \$100 raised in chapter fundraisers
 - 10 points for each Cookies & Cocoa 5K Sponsor
- 8. Social Media (Instagram)
 - 1 point per Repost/Comment
 - 2 points per Story Tag
 - 10 points per Post with Tag
