Dear Students/Parents/Guardians:

Thursday, November 11th is Veteran's Day, there is no school as it is a holiday. The Treaty of Versailles ended The Great War or World War I by stating that an armistice would go into effect on the eleventh hour of the eleventh day of the eleventh month, 11:00 AM, November 11, 1918. I remember hearing my grandfather tell stories of an Armistice Day celebration at "grammar school" when he was a child. An assembly would be held outdoors, students, special guests (I am sure veterans of The Great War), and teachers would give speeches and the school band would play music ending with "Taps" being played at 11:00 AM. This was prior to 1938, when November 11 was declared a federal legal holiday.

In 1954, after World War II, The United States Congress changed Armistice Day to Veteran's Day, a day to honor American veterans of all wars. For roughly eight years 1968-1975, Veteran's Day was celebrated on the Monday or Friday closest to November 11, which caused some confusion and many believed it distracted from the historic and patriotic significance of the date. Today, we celebrate November 11, as Veteran's Day, regardless of the day of the week.

The entire Marshall Middle School community extends our deepest appreciation to all veterans. I hope you find some way to honor our veterans this year. Thank you veterans!


