Students must earn 134 total credits and have a minimum of 60 credits minimum in order to become a Junior. Students must have passed 4 years of English, 4 years of Math, 3 years of Science and Social Studies, one semester of Physical Education/Health each year. Students also must pass at least one year or two semesters of Fine and Performing Arts/Occ. Ed courses and complete 36 hours of community service.
