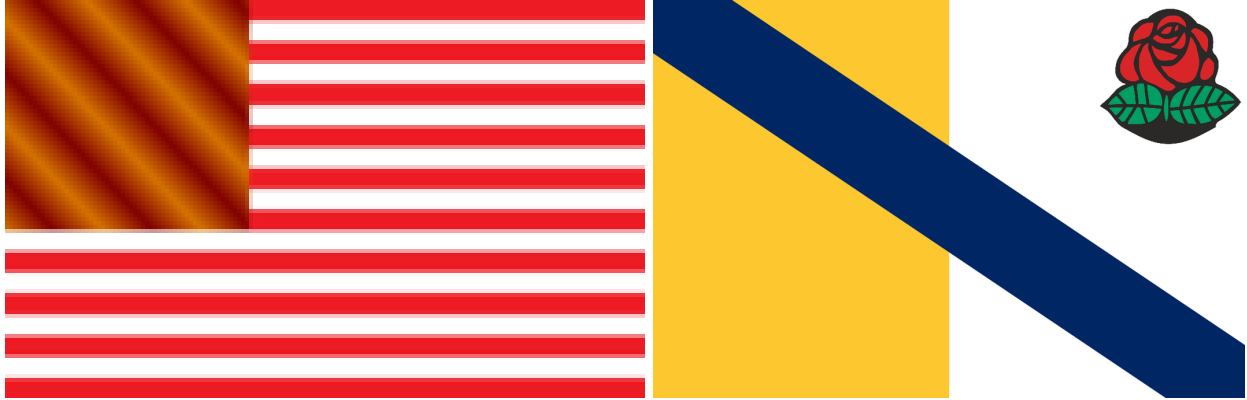




Treaty of Mutual Recognition

Having reviewed the compatibility between Desert District and the Grand Republic of Cycoldia in furthering relations between each other,

Taking into account the following treaty as the paveway for furthered relations between Desert District and the Grand Republic of Cycoldia,

Acknowledging the ability of the following treaty to be nullified in the event of the inability to maintain relations in any form or matter,

1. Declares the mutual recognition of both Desert District and the Grand Republic of Cycoldia by their counterpart in:
 - a. Sovereignty,
 - b. Political status;
2. Designates all territory claimed and held by Desert District as belonging to Desert District;
3. Designates all territory claimed and held by the Grand Republic of Cycoldia as belonging to the Grand Republic of Cycoldia;
4. Emphasizes the recognition of both nations' political statuses by their counterpart, even in, but not limited to:
 - a. Civil strife,
 - b. Conflict,
5. Affirms the mutual recognition and observance of laws and decrees of both Desert District and the Grand Republic of Cycoldia by their counterpart in territories, both claimed and held;
6. Endorses treaties concerning furthered relations between the Grand Republic of Cycoldia and Desert District at a later date;
