FREE MEDIA SOURCES • 2024

The following sites are resources for media that is free to use in most circumstances. Despite being free, pay special attention to how each piece of media is licensed and follow the rules of usage for that license as described below.

COPYRIGHT KEY: The resources listed here are labeled as following to indicate what general copyright category most of its media falls under. Please note that though a resource might be categorized under one type of license in this document, you are still responsible for double-checking the specific copyright information for any materials you find.

PD = Public Domain *or* a similar free license.

Good to go for any use, even commercial. Attribution may still be encouraged, though not required. Read more about the public domain here.


CC = Creative Commons *or* a similar free license.

Slow down and follow each piece of media's specific rules for use. For example, if a piece is licensed as <u>CC BY-SA</u>, this means you must provide attribution for that media and also license your work, created with that media, in the same way. Read more about Creative Commons <u>here</u>.

UN = Unconfirmed or may contain a variety of licenses.

Pause and research to confirm licensing information for any piece of media. If unable to find any licensing information, do not use that piece of media in your work.


