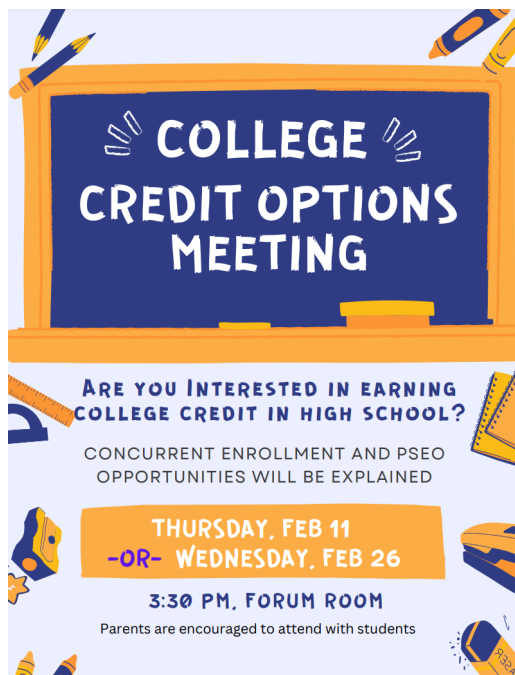

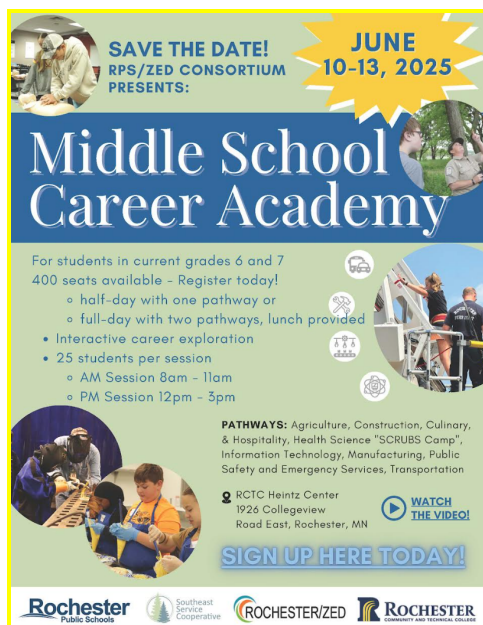

Lisa Laing passed away suddenly on April 7, 2010. In memory of her membership and duties; including secretary and co-chair of the Banquet for the Goodhue County Pheasants Forever Chapter, this scholarship was put into place by her husband Peter Laing in memory of her love for the outdoors.

The scholarship will reward \$2500.00 for a senior student who is pursuing a career in the outdoors. Examples: wildlife studies or environmental studies, work with the Minnesota DNR, or sciences including biology and earth science. The scholarship requires an application and video essay and will be decided upon by active members of the Goodhue Chapter of Pheasants Forever according to a rubric. This scholarship is open to any student attending High School in Goodhue County. All applications are due by Feb. 1st.

- Grade 9: 11:15-11:42 AM

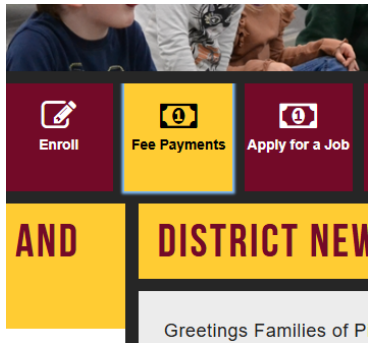

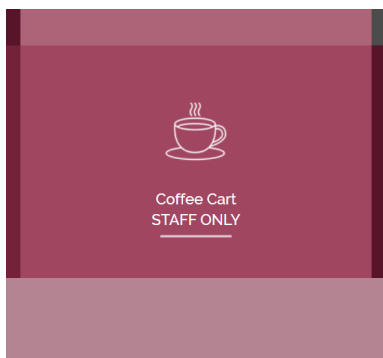
- You now can pay for coffee cart items online using a credit card.
