Interview Questions>

Do 131 instances have a chain of command?

Interview Goals>

Find out if eyepods have a chain of command, and identify where each instance is within the hierarchy.

Interview Result>

SCP-131 instances do have a chain of command.

-- RESEARCH DESCRIPTION --

Interview Preparations >

- Prepared documents and notepad to record 131 responses.
- Requested SCP-131-CYN, as well as required Eta-9/MP.
- Noted names of attending personnel.

Interview Phase>

(Entered the chamber and greeted the instances. Explained the reason for the interview and how I would conduct it. Began asking SCP-131-CYN questions).

Q1: "Who would you say is number one?" (In the chain of command).

A1: (All instances shine their lights on orange, who steps forward. Instances









confirm that nobody else holds the same rank.)

Q2: "How about number two?" (In the chain of command).

A2: (Red steps forward and the instances shine their light on him. They also confirm nobody else has the same rank).

Q3: "Now, anyone below them?"

A3: (Cyan shakes their head no).

Q4: "It's just Red and Orange, the rest are equal?"

A4: (All instances shake their head no).

Q5: "But there is no third in command, you said?"

A5: (Cyan begins quickly relaying morse code, catching me off guard).

(Cyan continues to quickly recite morse code, confusing me as the result comes across as gibberish. I ask for a moment, and turn to the Eta-9. As I do, Purple shows up around the corner, looking at the group and crying. I greet purple and ask him if he wants to join his friends. He declines. I turn back to the rest of the 131 instances).

Q6: "You aren't going to help your friend?"

A6: (The instances nod yes, refusing to speak to Purple).

(Most of the instances then move to the other end of the room, seemingly to harass purple. I turn back to Cyan, who remains with me).

Q7: "Let me ask again. Instead of all of the crew being equal, are most of the crew eaual?"

A7: (Cyan nods yes).

Q8: "Why do you not want to help Purple, do you hate them?"

A8: (Cyan nods yes).

(The instances all move towards Purple, and begin flashing their lights at him. Cyan then comes back to me).

Q9: "Going back to the chain of command, might purple be below everyone else?

A9: (Cyan nods yes).

Q10: "Is there a reason you don't like purple? We won't get into the details."

A10: (Cyan nods yes).

(Ended the interview after this question. The other 131 instances continued to









harass purple, while Eta-9 tried to defuse things).

Conclusion & Discoveries >

The findings are as follows:

- SCP-131 instances do have a chain of command.
- The chain of command is:
- 1. SCP-131-0 | Orange
- 2. SCP-131-R | Red
- 3. All other SCP-131 instances.
- 4. SCP-131-PPL | Purple
- SCP-131 instances hate SCP-131-PPL, and there is a reason why.


