Our Commitment

To maintain the highest standards of care and protection, the Board of Directors, Rugby Committee and Coaching Staff of Clwb Rygbi Nant Conwy formally declare that the club:

- **Adopts in Full** the official **Welsh Rugby Union (WRU) Safeguarding Policy** and all subsequent amendments.
- **Adheres to** the relevant guidance and statutory requirements set out by the WRU, the NSPCC's Child Protection in Sport Unit (CPSU), and Welsh Government legislation.
- **Implements** robust recruitment and vetting procedures, including mandatory DBS checks for all relevant volunteers and staff.
- **Promotes** a culture of vigilance where all members are encouraged to report concerns through the designated Club Safeguarding Officer (CSO).

Core Principles

1. **Inclusivity:** All participants, regardless of age, gender, ability, or background, have a right to protection from any form of abuse or poor practice.
2. **Responsibility:** Safeguarding is the collective responsibility of every coach, referee, parent, and volunteer within the Nant Conwy family.
3. **Responsiveness:** We ensure that any allegations or concerns are dealt with swiftly, professionally, and in accordance with the WRU reporting procedures.
