

## United Brethren Churches of North America Google Earth Project

This Google Earth project maps all United Brethren churches in the US and Canada. Where available, Google Street View is also included.

Churches can be located in several ways. When the project first opens up it will be in edit mode, where you can scroll through the list of churches and select the desired church or Street View. Locations are listed in alphabetical order by state or province, and church. If you click on one of the state or province names from the Table of Contents, the map will zoom to the state or province, where you can see all the churches located there. If you click on an individual church or Street View in the Table of Contents the map will fly to that location. If you click on a church on the map, the info box will open but the map view does not change.








From the info box you can enlarge the graphic or photo by clicking on it. There are also links that will take you to the church's website or Facebook page where available, or to the UBChurches.org information page.


Another way to view the churches is in Presentation mode, which is entered by clicking the Present button.




The next thing you will see is the title slide, where you can access the Table of Contents in the lower left corner of the screen:




If you like, you can begin looping through all churches and Street Views by clicking the forward and back buttons:



As there are a total of 341 items in the table of contents, you might prefer to find individual churches, states, or provinces. To do this, you can expand Table of Contents by clicking anywhere in the Table of Contents area:





At this point you can scroll to an individual state, province, or church, and begin the presentation from there by selecting the desired item, then clicking the forward and back buttons. You'll notice from the above graphic that the project also includes the historic Isaac Long barn in Lancaster, Pennsylvania, and the UB National Office in Huntington. You can return to edit mode by clicking the arrow at the upper left of the screen.
