Because you haven't played the My Little Pony: Friendship is Magic version yet, that's why!

Either way, below lie an assortment of mad libs, each one focusing on a different member of the ~~mane~~ main cast. Just scroll on down and give 'em a try, why don't ya?

For those that need more detailed instructions: This game is best played with multiple people, though it can work for only one player, too. One person, without looking at the story, reads off the checklist of required types of words, having the group decide what to fill in for each one as they go. Once there's a word for each entry, the reader inserts them, in order, into the blank spaces in the text on the next page, and reads the finished story aloud to the group. Be prepared to laugh hysterically! At least, that's the idea. Whether or not you derive humor from the nonsensical story you've crafted is ultimately up to you, I suppose. How does that saying go? Something about leading a horse to water? ...Nah, maybe I shouldn't use that here, it's too predictable.

Note that this file is, of course, not editable, so players are encouraged to either save their own copy and edit that, or print it off and play it the old-fashioned, paper-and-pencil way. Whatever floats your boat, really. Whatever you do, don't forget to have fun!
