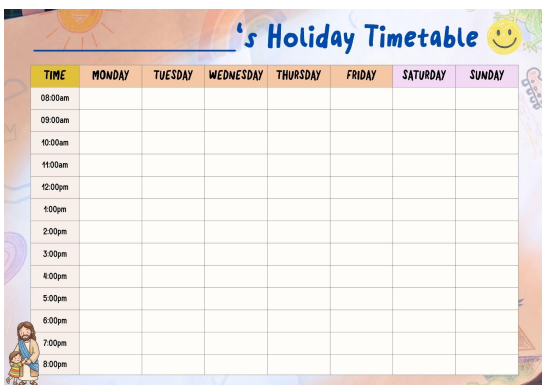
Activity: Planning my Timetable

- **Teacher Misha:** *HopeKids let's do an activity together today! Let's make our very own weekly timetable. You will all be given a template, Mon-Sun. Can you write when you wake up when you do your homework, when you practice your instruments or sports or drawing/painting (if you do have any of these skills), when you pray and read the Bible to know God more? Of course you can also include things like fun, screen time, etc. You can look at this template I have at the back here. What I want us to be very intentional to do is to include*

- Time with Jesus
- Time to do your homework / study
- Time to practice your talent

- **Teacher Misha:** *Remember the disciples experienced Jesus' power when they were practicing the things that God called them to do. They were doing boring things like washing their nets. For us, it could be boring things like doing homework or practicing our talents.*

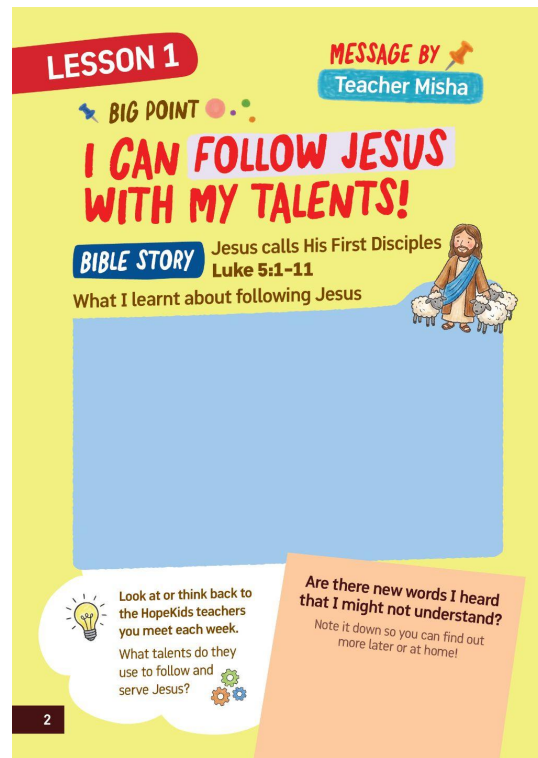

Activity: Reflection and Linking to Daily Life - Following Jesus with What I Do

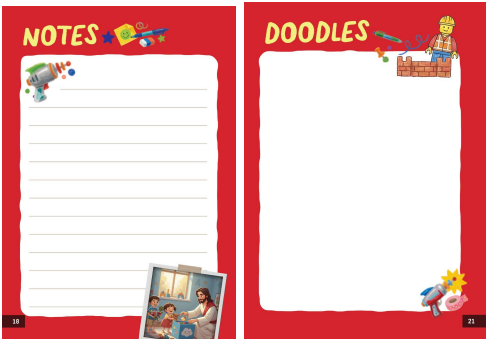
- Alright HopeKids, we just learnt that **we can follow Jesus with our Talents!**
- **Qn:** Do you remember what story we learnt from?
 - *Allow kids to respond.*
 - Well, if your journal is open, it's actually all there. We learnt from the story of how Jesus called His first disciples.
- **Qn:** What happened in the story? What did Jesus' first disciples work as before He called them?
 - *Allow kids to respond.*
 - That's right — they were fishermen! Fishing was what they knew how to do.
 - But Jesus called them to follow Him and use what they could do for Him. In the same way, we can follow Jesus with what we know how to do too! **We can follow Jesus with our talents!**

- Like what we heard from Teacher Misha today, if you look all around many of the HopeKids teachers you see are using their talents and what they can do to follow and serve Jesus.
- **Qn:** Now I want you to think, what are some things you can do? Let's just list down things you can do, things you are good at doing.

	○ <i>Allow some time for kids to think, reflect and write down.</i> ○ <i>Encourage them that God created all of us to be able to do some stuff: No matter how young you are, all of you have things that you know how to do. These are sometimes known as talent and they refer to your abilities.</i> ○ <i>Talents can also refer to things some people are naturally good at, and that is true, but talent can only grow if the person put in the hard work.</i> ○ <i>But in today's case, its about abilities, the things you know how to do – And whether it's singing, dancing, drawing or robotics or programming, God made you to be able to do or get good at doing that.</i> ● Qn: And now, let's think. How can you use your abilities to follow and serve Jesus? Remember how I mentioned that God made all of you able to do something? And you can one day use that to follow and love and serve Jesus. ○ <i>Allow some time.</i> ○ <i>E.g. I can use my voice to share about God's love. I can use my voice to sing to Jesus in worship.</i> ○ <i>E.g. I can use my friendliness to help new friends feel welcome in church.</i> ● And there is one thing you can do – it may not be a talent, but all of us can talk or think, and so you can PRAY! Prayer is talking to God and prayer is something all of you can do. Pray to God and ask Him to help you to know how you can follow Jesus more and more. Ask Him what your talents are, ask Him how you can use your talents and abilities

	to serve Him! Let's pray together now! Dear Jesus, I commit my talents to following You. Help me to use my talents and teach me to grow the things I know how (to do), so that I can love and serve you with my best! In Jesus' name, Amen! ===== If you notice, there is also space for you to write your own prayer. If you have things you would like to ask or tell God, feel free to take some time to write your own prayer. You can do this at home too!

Option #3: “Can Jesus Use This?” Game small group game

How to play:

- Teacher says different talents/abilities/items.
- Kids respond with two thumbs up 👍 or cross with their hands 🙅

Examples:

- singing
- helping
- encouraging
- being kind
- drawing
- cheating people (trick)
- hurting others (trick)
- football
- listening

Option #4: Talent Charades small group game

How to Play:

- Teacher will show a child using phone / a strip of paper an ability
- The child will act it out silently
- The rest of the children in the group has to guess what it is

Examples:

- Playing guitar
- Cooking
- Singing
- Cartwheel
- Playing piano
- Dancing
- Drawing / Painting
- Making drinks
- Welcoming people
