It's not exactly about capitalism, but I see I skipped some logical steps there. I suppose it's somewhat more an issue of republican ideology that competition is good and necessary, and "forcing" us to be constrained by laws for cooperative behavior (i.e., government regulation) is a refusal to accept the way things are. Primatologist Frans de Waal noted that the capitalist ethos has been built around an idea of competition (and mistaking the idea of "survival of the fittest" to be "of the strongest") being simply natural, while he highlights more the cooperativeness of primates. My sense is that stories of existence beyond death could give people reason to understand humans as connected to each other and having a larger purpose than merely survival, which might help them adopt a kinder perspective as well as overcome existential angst. Thanks for allowing me to clarify. I have no intent to promote an idea that atheists would be less ethical. Humanists I rather would far more trust to act compassionately than bible thumpers who justify their aggression based on some interpretation of justice.
