Registration Steps - Open Now!

Students **MUST REGISTER no later than Wednesday, December 31!** To complete your registration, follow these steps:

- 1. Your Parent/Guardian will go to https://roncalli.schooladminonline.com/
- 2. Your Parent/Guardian will sign in OR Create an Account.
- 3. Your Parent/Guardian will access the registration by entering the access code emailed to them by Mary Sheets, registrar
- 4. Your Parent/Guardian will review and update family data.
- 5. Your Parent/Guardian will submit a \$100 registration payment online or send in a check made out to Roncalli. Students MUST BE ENROLLED for the 2026-2027 school year in order to have their schedule added to Powerschool and ensure their course requests.
- 6. The registration fee increases \$150 after December 31, 2025.
- 7. Repeat for additional students.

Course Selection

- Students will be sent a link to Calendly to set up their appointment with their counselor to request their courses January 12th - January 22nd.
- Links will be sent on January 7th. You cannot sign up during a core class (English, Math, Science, Social Studies, or Theology) OR if you have a test or quiz.
- Students MUST choose a date and time in order to schedule for their junior year.
- If scheduling forms are not signed and returned to Guidance by Jan 16th, you will be taken out of AP
 courses! 8 period days will be considered AFTER all scheduling has taken place, unless required for
 graduation.

Additional Notes for Sophomores

- 1. If you are NOT registered before your scheduling appointment, your course requests are not guaranteed!
- 2. Consider taking Dual Credit classes as those may transfer to future colleges and save time and money!
