The Education Hub Store is where students and faculty members can download their own software titles and product keys for personal use.

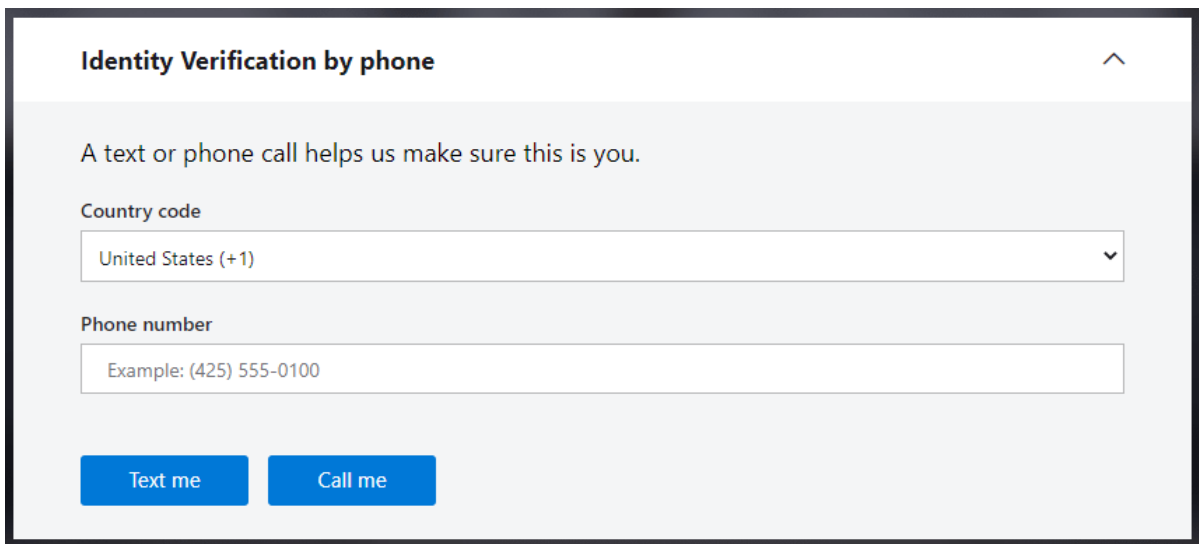

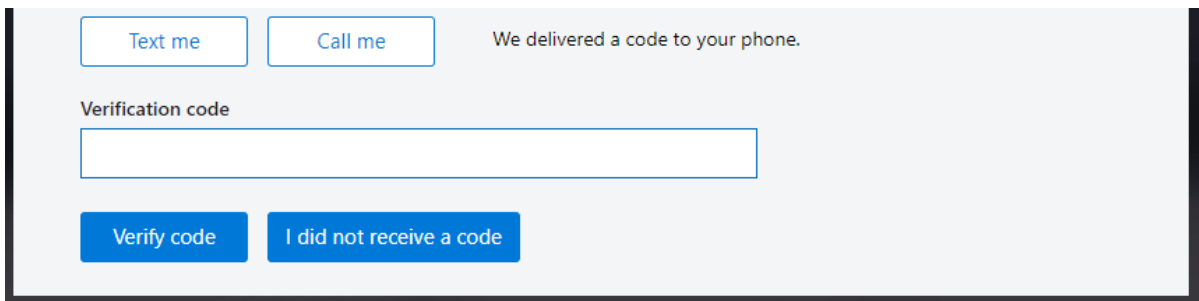
1. If you're signing in for the first time, you must verify your identity by phone. Open an InPrivate or Incognito tab go to:

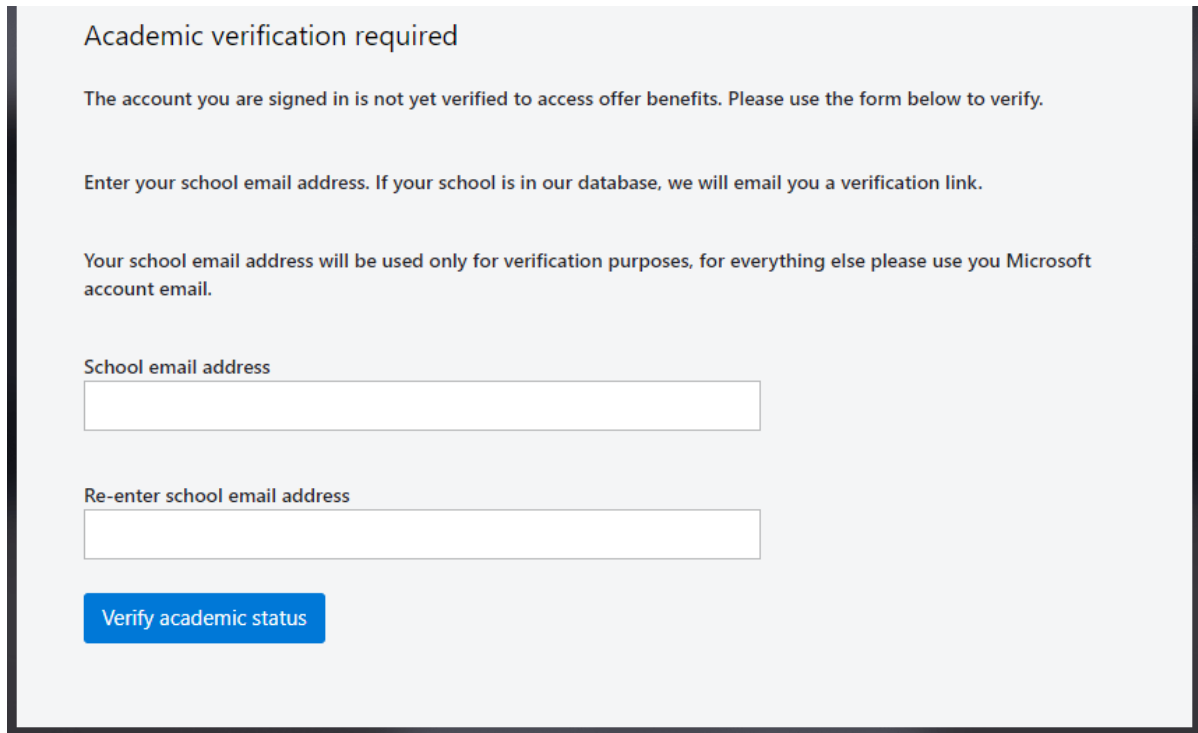

The following instructions work best if you already have an Office 365 (O365) account. You can set up an O365 account by going to: [Office.com/GetOffice365](https://office.com/GetOffice365)

1. After setting up your O365 account, use an InPrivate or Incognito browser, go to: <https://azureforeducation.microsoft.com/devtools>.
2. Click on the blue “Sign In” button
