 - Infographics
 - Taking words and images to tell a story
 - Retelling
 - Prints out on 1 page
 - Unlimited licensure for \$40
- Uses 1 account
- Organization Tip
 - Teach them how to curate themselves
- SMORE
 - SMM creates a SMORE
 - Students send it to you to link the SMORE
 - Purchased an account
 - Pathfinders in SMORE
 - Share it on to the Symbaloo

- Use to take pictures of letters to make as signs
- Keyboarding
 - Done in classrooms and NOT the library
- Give students a storyboard BEFORE project
 - Might do it in a Google Doc
 - Brainstorming together
- Padlet
 - Old "Wall Wisher"
 - Hooked to Google
 - Can store
 - Can decide layout
 - Stream
 - Share on Symbaloo or SMORE
 - Use as a tool to curate their work
 - easier than SMORE
 - Don't have to login
- Little Bird Tales
 - Only store so many
 - Delete them or buy for 99 cents

 - Build Your Wild Self
 - Screen shot
 - Little Bird Tales
 - Padlet
- Pic Monkey
 - Don't have to login
 - Any age can use
 - Crop, rotate, collages, etc.
 - Store it in Google Drive and download onto iPad
- SoundCloud
 - Shannon McClintock Miller uses for Poetry Month
 - Automatically creates podcasts
 - An app and online
 - Keep it private
 - Can hear their work
 - BUT can't share their work
 - ONLY tool Shannon keeps private

 - Create a link with a question
 - Put this link onto the Symbaloo
 - Capture their video and voice
- Pinwords
 - Take an image, change background
- Meograph
 - can be tricky
 - Timeline creators
 - Put in coordinates
 - Automatically creates the journey
