Each lesson will have four different topics. They are:

Lesson Thirteen

13-A Gospel

Read and highlight Acts 17:10-11 in yellow.

1. Are we to study after we give our lives to Jesus? (Yes we have the responsibility to see if the things we are told are true. We are to search the scriptures daily. We are to

always think.)

Read and highlight Matthew 28: 18-20 in yellow.

1. After we receive the gospel, then what do we do?
(We teach others. We baptize them and teach them to follow Jesus.)
2. Do we teach them to follow us? (No, we teach them to follow Jesus. We make them disciples or students of Jesus.)
3. Does Jesus help us? (Yes. "I am with you always, even to the end of the age.")

13-B, Identity and Grace

Read and highlight I Corinthians 6:9-11 in pink.

1. What will not inherit the kingdom of heaven?
(Unrighteousness)
2. What weaknesses had members of the Corinthian church overcome? (Sexually immoral, idol worshipers, cheating spouses, crossdressers, homosexuals, thieves,

drunks, partyers, people who wanted other people's things and people who cheated others.)

3. What does washed mean? (Sins washed away)

4. What does sanctified mean? (Made Holy)

5. What justified them? (Jesus)

Read and highlight I Peter 1:17-19 pink.

1. What were we redeemed with? (The blood of Jesus)

2. What does "Lamb unblemished" mean? (Without sin)

3. What does redeemed mean? (Purchased freedom)

Read and highlight Leviticus 25:47-49 pink.

1. How did people become slaves? (They had a debt they could not pay back)

2. How could a slave get back his freedom? (He could purchase it or one of his relatives could come and purchase it for him. This is called redeemer. This is foreshadowing the coming of the Christ and His redeeming us.)

Lesson 13-C, Encouragement

Read and highlight I Corinthians 10:12-13 in green.

1. What is the danger of thinking you are standing without help from God? (You will fall)

2. What does the text say about our temptation? (It is common. People all over have struggles just like ours)

3. What does the text say about the extent we are tempted? (God will not allow us to be tempted beyond what we are able)

4. What does God provide in the midst of temptation? (A righteous way out. A way to survive without sin.)

Read and highlight Hebrews 6:13-20 in green.

1. What did God swear by? (Himself)
2. What is it impossible for God to do? (Lie)
3. What does it mean to take refuge?
4. How does the hope of Jesus give us encouragement?
5. What does an anchor do?
6. How is our hope in Jesus like an anchor?

Lesson 13-D, The Church

Read I Peter 4:7-11 and highlight it in blue.

1. What does it mean to keep fervent in your love for each other?

2. What is hospitality? (Opening up your house and life to others)

3. Those who speak in the name of God should do it knowing what? (they are speaking the utterances of God)
