2026-2029 Three-Year Capital Plan

Each year, by April 1st, the Division is required to submit a Three-Year Capital Plan to Alberta Education's Capital Planning branch. The Board of Trustees have approved the following capital priorities for the 2026-2029 Three-Year Capital Plan:

1. Construction of a new K-8 replacement school in the North-East area of Wetaskiwin
2. A K-12 Ward 4 solution (Alder Flats, Buck Mountain Central, Winfield)
3. Modernization of Pigeon Lake Regional School
4. Modernization of CTS spaces at Wetaskiwin Composite High School
5. Replacement of the Clear Vista sprinkler system
