

PooPrints Resident Announcement Samples

*We know dog sh*t is weird, and you're probably tired of writing emails about it! This document serves as a guide for various announcement letters you may need to roll out the PooPrints program. Announcement

Dear [Community Name] Residents,

At [Community Name], we strive to create a welcoming environment for all our residents—both pet owners and non-pet owners. However, unscooped dog waste has become a significant concern for our community. It not only impacts the appearance of our grounds but also poses health and environmental risks.

To address this issue, we are implementing a new requirement for all dog owners in the community: participation in the PooPrints program, a trusted leader in pet waste management solutions. This program uses a simple DNA registration process to ensure fairness and accountability while promoting responsible pet ownership.

The PooPrints program has already been adopted by over 8,000 apartment communities, achieving up to a 96% reduction in unscooped waste on their grounds.

How It Works:

1. Register Your Dog: Visit [Community Pre-Registration Link] to provide basic details about your pet.

4. Waste Analysis: In the event unscooped waste is found on the property, it will be sent to the PooPrints lab for analysis. The DNA results will identify the pet responsible.
5. Accountability: Owners of identified pets will be notified by our property team and fined [\$] per violation. This system ensures accuracy and encourages all residents to clean up after their pets.

This program is now a required step for all dog owners. Please complete your registration by [Deadline]. Starting [Effective Date], any unscooped waste found on the property will be matched to a registered DNA profile, and fines will be issued to the responsible pet owner.

Reminder 1

Once the responsible pet is located and registration is completed, this stored data will be matched to the pet's DNA profile, and any previous waste incidents may result in fines. Completing your registration promptly ensures that your pet is included in the registry and avoids potential backdated penalties.

Deadline:

Please complete your registration by [Registration Deadline]. Failure to comply with this new requirement may result in fines or a violation of your lease agreement.

Reminder 2

Dear Residents,

We have received a few reports of unregistered dogs in our community. To address this, we would like to remind everyone about our PooPrints program and the importance of identifying and reporting unregistered pets.

Green Tag Identification

All PooPrints registered dogs should wear the green tag that came with their registration kit. This tag serves as a visual identifier confirming registration. If you see a dog without a green tag, please report it our team.

Tracking and Monitoring with PooPrints

For unregistered dogs, PooPrints creates a special profile. Any uncollected dog waste analyzed by PooPrints is securely stored in the system. Once an unregistered dog is identified and its registration is completed, any prior waste samples submitted will be matched to that dog's DNA profile. This ensures accountability for past and future incidents.

Our team is actively monitoring unregistered dogs to ensure compliance. We encourage everyone to help maintain a clean and pet-friendly community by registering pets and reporting any concerns.

Registration and Deadline Fees

The deadline to register dogs has passed. However, we recognize that some members of our community may not have completed this requirement. To encourage compliance, we are temporarily waiving the violation fine for unregistered dogs.
