



Mentee's Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. Can I see my mentor more than once a week?**

Typically, we schedule meetings once a week according to your school schedule. We do not want to interfere with your academic scheduling, so we will make every effort to ensure we follow your originally scheduled meeting day and time.
- 2. Am I allowed to call my mentor after school?**

No, to maintain privacy we do not allow mentors and mentees to share any contact information with each other. We will coordinate all contact between mentors and mentees. You will be able to interact and communicate with your mentor during mentoring sessions and events hosted by iC.A.R.E.
- 3. Can I make my mentor gifts?**

If you are interested, you may make a gift for your mentor to show your appreciation for taking the time to build a relationship, but it is not required. We ask that you keep the gifts school-appropriate.
- 4. Can I keep the same mentor next school year?**

Once you've been paired with a mentor, we will make every effort to ensure you keep the same mentor even if you transfer to a new school. If your mentor moves away or is unable to keep mentoring, then we will seek to match you with another mentor who we think will be a good fit for you.
- 5. Can I ask my mentor to help with my schoolwork?**

Yes, but your mentor's primary role is not that of a tutor. A mentor is a friend, role model, and caring adult whose primary purpose is to build a positive relationship with you.
- 6. Can I recommend a friend to be part of the program?**

Yes, you can recommend a friend to become part of the program. However, new mentees must be nominated and have their family's consent to get matched with a mentor.

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
