

# Gift Boxes

**Primary Materials:** paper

**True Size:** *varies*

**Scale Size:** *varies*

## Full List of Supplies

- cardstock paper
- OPTIONAL: glue stick

## Full List of Suggested Tools

- Xacto Knife
- Cutting Mat
- Printer

## Steps

1. Print the desired template (choose from below).
2. Cut on solid lines, and fold inward on all dotted lines. Make the folds crisp.
3. With paper upside down, fold entire sides (As) up to 90° angle. Bring ends inwards.
4. Bring flaps B and C up and bring B down to enclose a pair of flaps A.
  - a. C will end up being on the outside of the box, B on the inside.
5. OPTIONAL: Apply glue to inside of flap B before sealing. This will hold the box together. However, it isn't necessary, as the box does stay together without any glue or other adhesive.

## Notes

- I realize that my labels aren't the best for these templates. So, here's a clearer version to the right.
- These templates are designed to be printed on cardstock. They can be printed on standard A4/8.5x11 paper, but the lids will not fit as tightly.

## Box Templates

- [Largest Gift Boxes](#)  
This is the largest that can be printed on a standard sheet of paper. It fits well on an LGB flatbed car.  
There is also a smaller box, that uses the same lid.
- Scale Gift Boxes  
These are assorted sizes of scale gift boxes. They start at 12mm<sup>2</sup> (10.6 scale inches) and go up from there.
