MCCC-UM-Flint CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT OPTION

Beginning in the fall of 2021, MCCC will be partnering with the University of Michigan-Flint (UM-Flint) to offer a unique program that allows students to simultaneously complete an Associate of Applied Science in Nursing (AAS) degree and a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) degree. Enrollment in the concurrent enrollment option is not required to participate in the MCCC RN program. Students interested in participating in this option must be accepted into the RN (AAS) program at MCCC. Students interested in applying to this concurrent enrollment option should submit the MCCC-UM-Flint

In addition to the MCCC program and degree requirements, students enrolled in the collaboration agreement must complete extra coursework required for general education requirements at UM-Flint, as well as complete UM-Flint program requirements to earn the BSN degree. Courses required to satisfy UM-Flint's general education may be taken at either MCCC or UM-Flint. Some of the courses may also apply to program and/or degree requirements at MCCC. Students are encouraged to review the Collaborative AAS/BSN Program agreement on file with the MCCC Registrar's Office and made available online by visiting <http://www.monroecc.edu/academicadv-transfer/transindex.htm>. The table below outlines extra courses that will be required to complete the BSN degree. Some of these courses may also satisfy general education requirements at MCCC.

Students will receive up to 30 transfer credits once they pass their NCLEX and complete at least 1 semester at UM-Flint. These credits can be used towards the overall 120 college credits needed for the degree. Please make sure to work closely with a UM-Flint and MCCC advisor.

Students are strongly encouraged to work with an academic advisor to determine the likelihood of program completion and develop a plan for course completion that is realistic and will result in the timely completion of the degree. Policies related to progression in MCCC's program will apply. Students will be eligible for NCLEX testing and licensure upon completion of the MCCC RN (AAS) program.

The curriculum plan for each cohort starts includes only required prerequisites, major requirements, and the order of completing these courses at both institutions. MTA requires non-nursing courses for the BSN degree, and UM-Flint general education courses are *not* included and may be completed during a semester at the student's discretion. A MCCC-UM-Flint Concurrent Enrollment Option Advising Sheet is available to students in the Admissions Office and the Health Sciences Division Office to assist with planning and course tracking. The Advising Sheet lists all courses required to complete the MCCC AAS (RN) degree and the UM-Flint BSN-Completion degree.

The MCCC/UM-Flint Collaborative Agreement requires 120 total credit hours of instruction to earn the BSN degree. Please see the Collaborative AAS/BSN Program agreement on file with the MCCC Registrar's Office or online at <http://www.monroecc.edu/academicadv-transfer/transindex.htm> to see the breakdown of credit hours and requirements by institution and degree.

MCCC's RN (AAS) program is accredited by the Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing (ACEN). UM-Flint's BSN program is accredited by the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE). With the pathways below, students can complete their BSN in **3 years, including all prerequisite courses and general education requirements for both Monroe and UM-Flint.**
