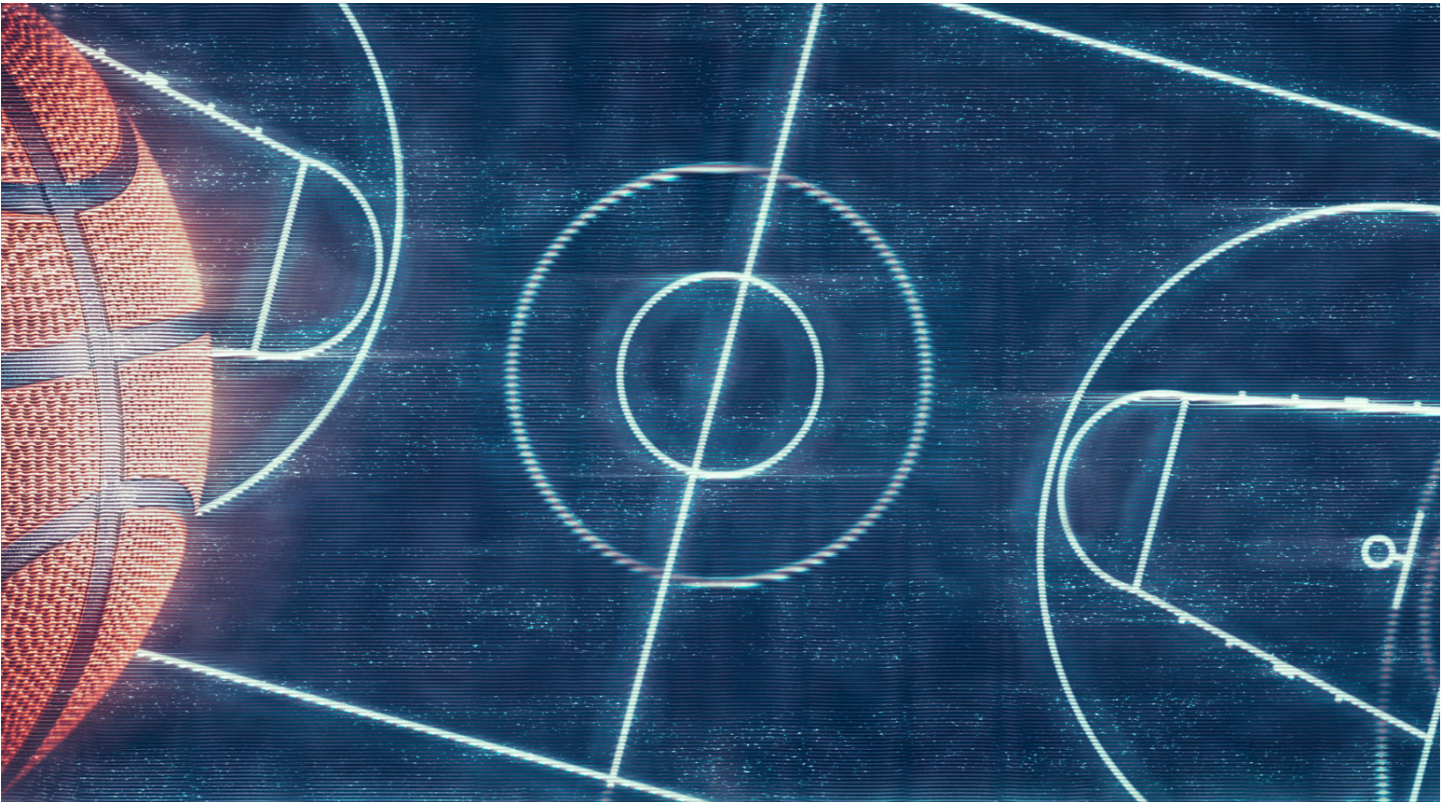

- We have had a few bus route cancellations due to staffing shortages. **To get updates on bus route cancellations, please join our REMIND messaging system by texting the number 81010 with the message "@hvr school"** Please remember if a bus route is canceled it will be for both the AM/PM.
 - **Please discuss bus behavior with your child. We are suspending many student bus privileges due to misbehavior. The expectation is they stay seated, keep**

their hands to themselves, don't throw objects inside the bus or out the windows, listen to the bus driver, and use appropriate language. The safety of our students is imperative and we will not tolerate students that cannot meet the expectation of riding the bus appropriately.

- The transportation department is using “Letters” instead of bus numbers. The letters are on the bus route schedule link found in this update as well as the Taylor School Districts website.
 - We have had to address many behavioral issues on our buses the first week of school. Students that cannot behave on the bus will unfortunately lose bus privileges.

- Per the Student Code of Conduct, phones are not to be used in Taylor Public Schools. Additionally, Hoover Middle School's phone policy states that confiscated phones must be picked up by a parent or guardian on the second offense. Please speak with your child about refraining from using cell phones during school hours.
 - As a reminder for parents and students, every classroom has a working phone. Students may use these phones to call home and a parent may call the office to contact their student at 313-295-5775.
- Every student should have a school-issued chromebook at this time. It is imperative that they bring their charged chromebook to school each day. If your student is having issues with their chromebook, please have them report to the library for assistance.
- **I-Ready:** Every Hoover student is asked to pass at least 1 lesson each in math & reading a week. In October, over 120 prizes were given to our Hoover students. Our new contest begins Monday, where Social Studies classes are competing against each other. Each social studies teacher will have 1 class win in November. To win, only students who participate can win prizes. Students earn a point for their class with each lesson passed in math and reading. The points will be divided by the number of students in the room to see which class ends up with the highest percentage of points per enrolled student. Let's Go Hawks!!
