About the Golden Valley Historical Society. Now in its 50th year, the Golden Valley Historical Society (GVHS) was organized in 1974 and is dedicated to the preservation and celebration of Golden Valley history. Its mission is to find, preserve, and disseminate historical knowledge about the City of Golden Valley. In 1997, GVHS acquired the city's oldest church building as a permanent home. The original chapel was constructed in 1882 and is available for weddings, vow renewals, memorial services, and a variety of presentations. GVHS opened the Golden Valley History Museum in 2018. In 2020, the museum received an Award of Excellence from the American Association of State and Local History for its "Golden Valley: No Place Like Home" exhibit. Both the Historic Church and Museum are operated by GVHS. The Society also collects and preserves oral histories, photographs, three-dimensional objects, and archives that tell the story of Golden Valley's history.
