### Literacy

This week the students returned to making targeted connections to their reading
with text-to-self, text-to-text, and text-to-world connections. Text-to-self
connections are highly personal connections that a reader makes between a piece
of reading material and the reader's own experiences or life. Sometimes when
reading, readers are reminded of other things that they have read, other books by

the same author, stories from a similar genre, or perhaps on the same





topic. These types of connections are text-to-text connections. While text-to-world connections are the larger connections that a reader brings to a reading situation. Such connections help students comprehend better and more fully engage with a text. "Visiting" gorillas in Rwanda and comparing texts concerning Native Peoples of North America were just two of the many ways in which students practised making these connections this week.
