Make sure you include everything you can so that it comes across clearly to all those who view it prior to voting.

Your Prom Theme should be presented as a Google Slide for your entire senior class to view. After each has been viewed we will present them to the senior class. Presentations will be posted to the district website and emailed out to everyone through your sailornet accounts. A google form for voting will be sent out for you to pick your favorite! YOU ARE TO KEEP THIS ANONYMOUS! NO NAMES ON THE SUBMISSION SLIDES!

#### Main Ideas to include:

- WHAT IS THE THEME?!? GIVE IT A NAME! COLORS? Main Focal Points; Additional Decor added around the hall, DJ table etc.
- RED CARPET ARRIVAL: What do you want the red carpet arrival to look like this year? Any decorations, props, the way attendees arrive; what ideas do you have to truly make this look like the real thing?
- THE MAIN HALLWAY: When you enter the main hallway after leaving the gym and library, what would you like to enter to? What could we do to additionally dress up this entrance?
- TABLE SCAPES: What should the tables look like? Centerpieces? Colors? Decorations?

- FAVORS: What would you like to take home as a memory of this event? Do you want to take anything home as a memory? You make the call on how the funds are spent.
- Add any additional information that you feel adds to your theme and may convince others that your theme is the best!

### Red Carpet Arrival:

~ 6:30pm through the Gymnasium ~ Students may choose to arrive in the most creative, appropriate ways possible! ~ Students are not required to participate in the Red Carpet Arrival & Announcing/Procession to attend Prom.

## **Ticket Sales:**

~ All tickets will be \$90 ~ Ticket Sales will begin the week of April 6, 2026. ~ All School Fees must be paid in order to purchase a ticket.

~ All tickets purchased after May 1, 2026 will cost \$100. ~ No tickets will be sold after May 12, 2026.

~ All ticket sales and deadlines are subject to change and only if it benefits the students.

#### Table Reservations:

- ~ All table reservations must be made by May 13, 2026. ~ If reservations are not made by 5/13/26, advisors will do their best to accommodate appropriately.
  - ~ Reservation sheets will be located in the main office.
    - ~ Tables for groups of 6, 8, 10, or 12 can be reserved
  - ~ Tables can only be reserved when tickets for all at the table have been purchased!

## Dance:

- ~ No student will be allowed to enter after 7:30pm (unless written permission by the administration).
- ~ Parents will be contacted for students who have not arrived.
- ~ Once students have left Prom they will not be allowed re-admittance.
  - ~ All guests (non-VHS students) must have a dance/guest form on file.
  - ~ Upon entrance all attendees will be subject to a breathalyzer test.
  - ~ Any large bags or purses are subject to a search.
- ~ Any large bags brought into the dance will be held by administration until the attendees are ready to leave.
- ~We ask that all attendees are appropriately dressed. All accessories such as top hats, canes, etc will be held by administration until the attendees are ready to leave.
  - ~ Any student in attendance that behaves inappropriately will be asked to leave and only released with parent/guardian acknowledgment.

- ~ Senior Breakfast: immediately following picture

- ~ Superlatives will be sent out in a Google Form to all Senior sailornet account emails.
- ~Superlatives will be emailed out approximately the week of May 4, 2026 and due back no later than May 15, 2026.

## Graduation Practice: May 26, 2026

- ~ During practice students will also receive their recognition cords, stoles, and tassels.
- ~ Graduates may also receive any final bills or paperwork.
- ~ All fees must be paid in full in order to participate in the graduation ceremony and receive their diplomas. If fees are not paid in time students are permitted to walk but will not be able to receive their diplomas until payments are made(an empty binder will be handed to the senior during the ceremony). Diplomas can then be picked up in the VHS Main Office when payment occurs.
- ~ Any Senior interested in speaking or performing at graduation must submit a copy of their speech or performance prior to *May 8, 2026*. Those students chosen are then expected to share a Google Doc of their speech with Mrs. Caffarel, Mrs. Habermehl, Mr. Perry, Ms. Burris, and Mr. Snook by May 20. (The top three of those submitted will be determined by senior class advisors, administrators, etc. If needed, an anonymous reading and choosing will be held by a panel of staff members.)
- ~ Assigned seating will be posted for all seniors to follow.
- ~ All Seniors MUST be at graduation practice in order to participate in the Commencement Ceremonies on Sunday, May 31, 2026.
- ~ All Seniors are expected to bring their caps and gowns to practice. It is advised that tassels are left at home so as to not be lost.

## Cap and Gown Walk:

### May 26, 2026

- ~ The Annual Cap and Gown Walk will follow graduation practice at approximately 10:30am.
  - ~ Seniors will first parade through VHS as our underclassmen clap them out!
- ~ Seniors will then exit the South Gym Doors and parade to Vermilion Elementary School to be greeted and congratulated by our elementary school students, faculty, and staff.
  - ~ Seniors will then walk to Sailorway Middle School to be greeted and congratulated by our elementary school students, faculty, and staff.
- ~ We encourage all Alumni, Retirees, Family and Friends to line the walk to VES and join in efforts to congratulate the Class of 2026.

## Senior Scholarship Night:

May 20, 2026 7:00pm Vermilion High School Auditorium

~ All Seniors and their families are invited to attend. ~Information will be posted on the district website for those who will be recipients of the local scholarships. ~ Appropriate dress is highly suggested. Dressing up, business attire is appropriate. Very short skirts are discouraged. Women's stiletto, wedge, or other high heel shoes are discouraged(falling/tripping risk). Recipients will be using the stairs to the stage.

## Payment of Senior Fees:

## Commencement Ceremonies:

~ Doors will open at llam.

~ No Jeans, Shorts, Gym Shoes, Work Boots, or Flip Flops, please. Red collar shirts are not suggested since they do not photograph well with the purple gowns.

~ At the conclusion of the Commencement Ceremonies we ask all in attendance to remain seated until the Graduates have exited.

~ The Graduates Ceremonial Cap Toss may occur where they are seated in the gym if it is raining. If weather permits the graduates will exit and do the cap toss outside the gymnasium under the large tree.

~ Decorating the mortar boards MUST be respectful and if not will be confiscated prior to the ceremony.

~ All graduates are encouraged to put their names inside their caps.
