Be The Solution

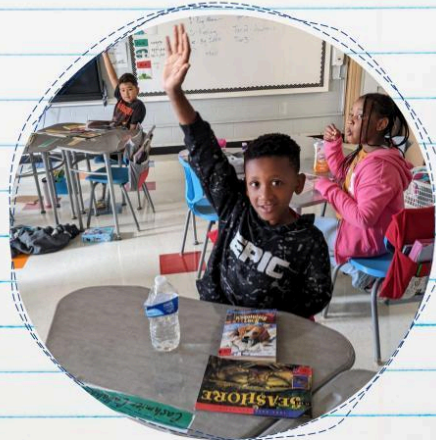
Attendance is always important!
