

Calhoun High School National Honor Society Policy

A demerit will be given for each infraction. If three demerits are given, the member will be put on Probation.

If an officer receives three demerits, he or she will be demoted and will also be put on Probation. He or she will then write a statement which will be read before the Faculty Council to determine future member status. The member will receive a letter explaining the decision of the Faculty Council.

If the member receives a discipline referral, he or she will go before the Faculty Committee to determine future member status.

*During a period of Probation, the member will be given a written notice that he or she is on probation and will go before the Faculty Council to determine future member status. The member's statement will be read to the Faculty Council during the hearing in order to plead his or her case before the Faculty Council. If a member is dismissed from the NHS, he or she will not be able to join the following semester.

INFRACTIONS WILL BE GIVEN IF THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA ARE NOT MET:

Members must attend all functions/meetings. If a situation occurs where the member is unable to attend, he or she must contact an advisor PRIOR to the absence explaining the situation.

Members must complete all duties he or she has been assigned. In the event of an absence, he or she must ensure an advisor has been informed and his or her duties have been covered.

Community Service Hour Requirements Total:

Seniors Inducted (Last Year)	total of 60 hours
Seniors Inducted (This Year)	total of 20 hours
Juniors Inducted (This Year)	20 hours by the end of spring semester

NHS requires 20 hours **PER semester in order to meet criterion and to wear the NHS stole at graduation

Community Service Hours are obtained by working NHS community service projects. Other ways to get community service are through many organizations in town as well as other opportunities at Calhoun City Schools.

GPA Requirements

You must maintain a **95** academic GPA in order to remain in good standing with the National Honor Society. Failure to meet this requirement will result in Probation until the next grading period. Failure to do so after the aforementioned grading period will result in a meeting of the Faculty Council to determine your violation of the scholarship pillar.
