What we've done

- Implementing authentication on the API
- Working on the sequencing for the form following testing and making changes, like not asking about stories to people doing ground floor extensions
- We did some more testing. Unfortunately having to use a clickable prototype didn't allow us to test the complex logic aspects so we'll be testing the live application next time
- The API will now give us the use class. Some properties will have multiple use classes. It will return both.
- Simplifying how to query the database so that it can return TPO, Boundaries etc as 1 query not separate ones
- We ran a show and tell in Planning and held a retro with the team

Key decisions

- We're not going to test with planners anymore. We want a full set of architects/general public for next time as they are our users
- We wont be integrating a payment system as we wont be sending the data anywhere. We'll
 design and develop payment calculation and any aspects that sit around payment

What's next

 We planned the next sprint which will be focused on building the accounts and working on payment
