## Off-Campus Lunch Pass: Junior Privilege Application

Applications Due by January 16th<sup>1</sup>, 2020 to Mr. Derricott, in the Library.

A second-semester junior is eligible for off-campus lunch provided that he/she meets specific qualifications and does not violate school policies pertaining to the **Responsibilities Earns Privileges Program**. Once earning the privilege to leave campus at lunch, the student will forfeit it for the remainder of the year if she/he is suspended for any reason or earns a D or F at the end of the grading period. "Junior Privilege" does not entitle student-parking privileges. Any student leaving campus is expected to represent Spring Valley High School in an exemplary manner characteristic of Viking behavior and academics.

1. Only students who have earned the required units to be classified as a junior for the current school year may apply for junior privilege.
2. Issuance of a junior privilege ID is dependent on maintaining a 70 average in each class, no suspensions, and no outstanding fees.
3. Students must have a valid Junior Privilege ID card in order to leave campus during lunch.
4. Students with junior privileges can not take students off campus who are not authorized to leave. This includes juniors who have not been granted permission or who do not have a valid junior privilege ID.
5. Students are not allowed to pass their junior privilege ID card to other students. Doing so will cause those students involved to lose their privilege permanently and other disciplinary action.
6. Students with junior privileges will maintain an acceptable conduct record in accordance with the policies of Spring Valley High School.
7. **Students are responsible for returning to school in a punctual manner before their 5<sup>th</sup> period class. After the third tardy, students will lose their Junior Privilege status.**
8. Students who do not meet the qualifications for the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter will be allowed to apply for junior privileges for the 4<sup>th</sup> nine weeks.
9. Students must turn in old ID or pay five dollars to get the Junior Privilege ID
10. Students who lose their ID must email Mr. Derricott concerning getting a replacement.
