To be prepared for the learning fair, each district/school team should bring an artifact that summarizes how the learning is being used in their school/district. This artifact can be a handout, slide deck, one-pager, tri-fold presentation board, or any other medium you would like to use. We strongly recommend that any digital artifact include a QR code or bit.ly for easier viewing. If you opt for a physical handout, we suggest bringing 50 copies. **To allow other participants to preview your presentation, designate one representative from your district/school team to submit your topic and overview in the table below.** **Please submit your topic in the first empty row.**

Learning Fair Flow:

1. Following lunch, you will set up your team's exhibit on one of the designated tables.
2. Someone from your team will be designated to host your exhibit during each of the three rounds. We recommend a rotation so everyone can see the other teams' exhibits.
3. Be prepared to share and engage colleagues in dialogue during the 10-minute block designated per round.

Time, Structure, & Protocol:

- Three 10-minute rounds will comprise this portion of our session.
- During each round, participants will move about visiting different learning stations.
- Session facilitators will announce the end of each 10-minute round and allocate 2 minutes for movement before announcing the beginning of the next round. This will enable you to window shop before deciding where to stop and learn during the upcoming round.
