



JANITORIAL VOLUNTEER

The Janitorial Volunteer plays a key role in maintaining a clean, safe, and welcoming environment at the RE:center. This role supports daily operations by ensuring that all spaces are well cared for and ready to serve the community.

Responsibilities include cleaning and sanitizing common areas, restrooms, and high-touch surfaces, emptying trash, maintaining floors, organizing spaces, and supporting general upkeep both inside and outside the facility. Volunteers may also assist with inventory of cleaning supplies, light maintenance tasks, and preparing spaces for daily activities or special events.

This role requires attention to detail, reliability, and a willingness to contribute to a team-oriented environment. Volunteers should be comfortable working in a fast-paced setting and interacting respectfully with individuals from diverse backgrounds.

Volunteer hours are flexible between 8 am and 4 pm, Monday through Thursday. Once a schedule is established, consistency is expected.

This role may require lifting up to 50 pounds and performing physical tasks such as bending, standing, and walking for extended periods.

A background check is required.
