The Faculty Success Program through the [National Center for Faculty Development & Diversity](#) (NCFDD) is a 12-week online program that helps tenure-track and tenured faculty develop the skills necessary to increase research and writing productivity while maintaining a healthy work-life balance. The mid-career faculty are highly encouraged to apply.

Application deadline: March 4th, 2022.

Applications will be reviewed by a selection committee, and you will be notified no later than **March 10, 2022** of the decision.
