Major Notes:

- DSS 100 Excel Competency is a one credit online course that must be completed by the end of freshman year. The course is offered in fall and spring semesters and is a pre-requisite for ACC 102 and DSS 200.
- DSS 210 is a pre-req for DSS 220 and should be taken first, DSS 200 is not and can be taken either semester.
- Business Administration Major Electives: Choose two (2) upper division courses from three different departments (for prerequisites, see course descriptions of the upper division courses). Choose among:
 - Accounting
 - Business Intelligence
 - Finance
 - o Food, Pharmaceutical, and Healthcare
 - Management
 - Marketing

These courses must be in addition to any course that is part of the Business core and must be in three different <u>departments</u>, not majors. For example, you cannot take two in Managing Human Capital and two in Family Business and Entrepreneurship and two in International Business and have all six courses count for the BSA major elective courses as these majors are all in the Management Department. Business Administration majors cannot have a second major or minor in another Haub School of Business program

- Please see the <u>Business Administration section of the online catalog</u> for courses that meet the ILC requirement.
- To satisfy the natural science requirement, the student may take either <u>one-credit</u> laboratory course or <u>two</u> 3-credit non-laboratory courses. If choosing the 2 semester option, the second course replaces an elective.
- Overlays: In selecting courses, students will be required to identify courses that meet the overlay requirements in the areas of 1) Diversity 2) Diversity, Globalization or Non-Western Area Studies, 2) Ethics Intensive and 3) Writing Intensive. Many of the courses already in your schedule may cover these areas.
