Opening and Attendance

- The meeting began at 4:03 PM.
- The agenda and previous meeting minutes were reviewed, and motions were made to approve them.

School Site Council Goals and Updates

Goal 1: College and Career Readiness

- **Parent Counseling Night**: Held on September 25th with presentations in English, Spanish, and Vietnamese. Presentations are available on the school website.
- **Grade Level Presentations**: Conducted in classrooms for freshmen, sophomores, juniors, and seniors to streamline collaboration with classroom teachers.
- Cohort Grouping: Special cohorts like the Latino cohort and special ed push-in models were discussed, aiming for inclusion and community engagement.

- California College Guidance Initiative (CCGI): Introduced as a replacement for Naviance, aiding students in career mapping.
- **Senior Graduation and Honor Night**: Scheduled for a Wednesday to avoid confusion, with options to borrow caps and gowns.
- Executive Summary

Attendance and Engagement Initiatives

- Attendance Awareness Campaign: Aimed to increase attendance by 2%, focused on students with around 10% absenteeism.
- **Raffle Incentives**: Implemented an attendance streak reward system with raffle tickets and prizes for consistent attendance.
- **Positive Trends**: Notable decrease in truancy rates and chronic absenteeism, showcasing effective engagement strategies.
- **Saturday School**: Promoted for additional support and recapture of ADA funds, offering community service opportunities.

Goal 4: Behavior Response and School Climate

- School-wide Rally: Held during school hours to promote inclusivity and foster a positive school climate.
- Coordinated Care Team: Handles referrals for behavior, academics, and mental health, with team-based intervention plans.
- **Improvement Celebrations**: Recognizes students showing progress in attendance, behavior, academics, or engagement.

Proposition 28: Arts and Music Funding

- Funding Allocation: Silver Creek High School allocated \$300,000 per year to be used for Visual and Performing Arts (VAPA) subjects, not supplanting existing programs.
- **Survey for Spending**: Conducted to gather feedback from students, parents, and stakeholders on how to utilize the funds effectively.
- Supplement vs. Supplant Explanation: Clarified the difference, emphasizing the funds should supplement current offerings.

Student Activities and Engagement

- Club Rush: Successful event with increased student interaction and diversity of clubs.
- Homecoming Events: Highlighted alumni game turnout, student participation, and media coverage.
- **Spirit Week and TEDx Event**: Engaged students and staff in themed activities and showcased student speakers and performers.
- **Upcoming Events**: Spirit week and annual non-fire event planned, with leadership preparing for high participation.

Additional Updates

- Avenue of Altars Event: Scheduled for October 30th, engaging the Latino Parent Coalition and student cohorts in cultural celebration.
- **ASSETS Program**: Reintroduced with tutoring, driver's ed, and weight training, funded by a budget of \$12,000 for necessary equipment.

- The meeting concluded with the next scheduled meeting on November 14th.
- A request was made for participants to complete the Prop 28 survey linked in the agenda. A motion was made to adjourn the meeting, seconded, and approved.
