

Ecker Family Cemetery — Section 7 accessed from CR 350 W south of SR 14.

The Ecker family is said to be the first settlers in Washington township. In 1837 they settled in the middle of Section 7. The eight remaining stones are on a wooded knoll of what has for several years been owned by the Kuckuck family. The cemetery is now owned by Anthony Kuckuck 3939 SR 14 W but is accessed from CR 350 W. on the south side of SR 14.
