VERDICT: Several red flags suggest The <u>AZ Code</u> is not legitimate: Hidden creator identities, coupled with exaggerated and unrealistic income claims mean this system is highly unlikely to deliver the promised results. On the plus side the program does have a refund guarantee.

What is The AZ Code?

The AZ Code claims to give you access to a special Amazon secret code that can allow anyone to make commissions on a daily basis.

First of all, The AZ Code promises that anyone can take advantage of this opportunity. Secondly, it does not require any special knowledge, skill, or expertise.

The AZ Code is not similar to the Amazon Affiliate income model. It's something unique and different, as per the introductory video. The introductory video presentation also mentions that many people have already tried and tested this with proven results.

The only criterion is that you should be located in the US to use this online income-making opportunity through The AZ Code.

Who is Behind The AZ Code?

Is The AZ Code Legit?
