## How to Make Viral Ads With Al

User-generated content (UGC) ads are revolutionizing modern marketing with authentic and relatable content that drives engagement.

**BUT...** Creating high-quality UGC ads can often be time-consuming and costly.

#### Tips to make your ads stand out

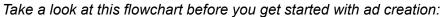
- **Keep It Short** Short videos (1-3 mins) work best for social media, while tutorials can be 5-10 mins. Focus on key points and avoid detailed descriptions.
- **Branded Colors and Fonts** When you are making multiple ads, keep the branding consistent with colors, fonts, and visuals to build a better recall for your product.
- Optimize for Mobile Viewing Since most viewers use mobile devices, ensure text is readable and graphics clear on smaller screens.

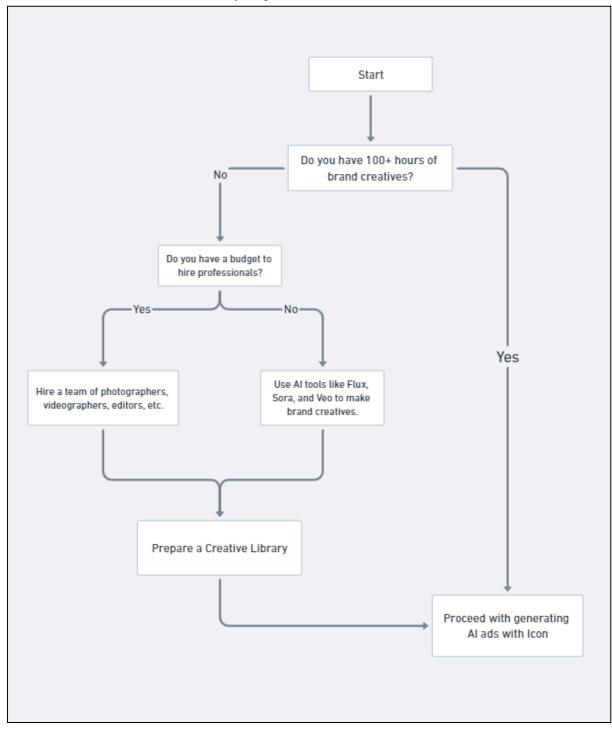
Also make sure you include a strong call-to-action to encourage viewers to visit your website, subscribe, or share the video. This helps actively convert a user's intent into action.

The **Pain-Agitation-Solution (PAS)** model is known to be the most impactful simplest way to create content that connects with your audience. It's all about showing empathy, building urgency, and offering the perfect solution.

- Pain: Call out the problem your audience faces—something relatable and frustrating.
- Agitation: Dig deeper, showing why that problem is such a hassle. Make them feel it!
- **Solution**: Introduce your product as the easy fix that solves it all.

## **Building Your Creative Library**





You can use a combination of AI tools to create media asset files for your AI-generated Creative Library. Here are a few examples of AI image-generation tools:

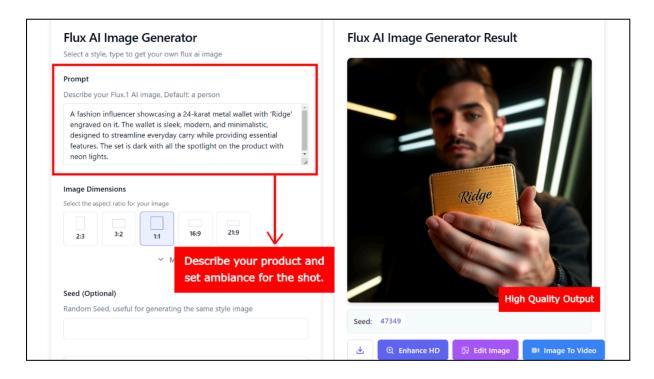

#### **Generate Images from Prompts**

Here's a step-by-step process for Flux to generate Al images:

- 1. Go to <a href="https://flux1.ai/create">https://flux1.ai/create</a> to get started.
- Describe your product, the ambiance of the shot, lighting, product placement, etc. to give enough context to the AI model for your photoshoot. The more detailed it is, the better.
- 3. Define the image dimensions before generating the prompt. It is a good idea to generate multiple images for the same prompt and with different aspect ratios.
- 4. Click on 'Run' to generate your image.

**Example Prompt:** A fashion influencer showcasing a 24-karat metal wallet with 'Ridge' engraved on it. The wallet is sleek, modern, and minimalistic, designed to streamline everyday carry while providing essential features. The set is dark with all the spotlight on the product with neon lights.



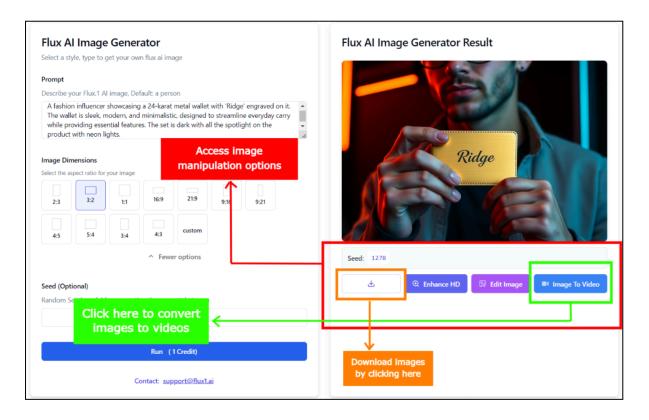
**Note:** If you want to recreate the same result for consistency (useful in A/B testing or design revisions), you can set a seed value before hitting 'Run'.

Seed value offers more control over the randomness involved in image generation. If you use the same seed value and prompt multiple times, Flux will generate the same image every time.

Here are a few examples of visuals generated by Flux AI with the same prompt and diff seed:



Flux also allows you to further make changes to the generated images. You can enhance the image, manipulate parts of the image per your requirements, or create a video from it.

#### Modified image

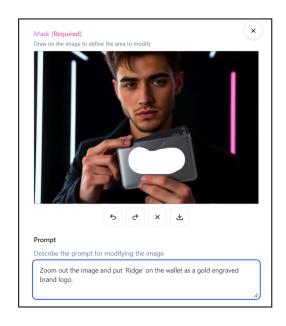




To make changes to your existing images in your creative library, follow these steps:

- 1. Upload the image to Flux AI in the Image Edit dashboard.
- 2. Add a mask to your images Highlight the part of the image you wish to modify
- 3. Describe your changes in the prompt section
- 4. Click on 'Generate Image'.

You can do this multiple times to achieve your desired modifications or generate different variations of the same image modification.



Here's an example of the same:

**Prompt:** Zoom out the image and put 'Ridge' on the wallet as a gold engraved brand logo.

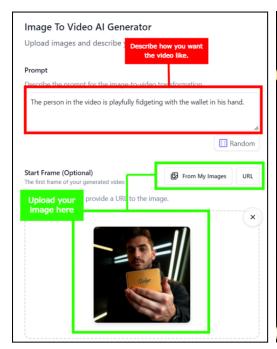






#### **Generate Videos from Images**

- 1. Upload your images to Flux or click on 'Image to Video' after you've created your img.
- 2. Describe how you want the video to come out and click on 'Generate Video'

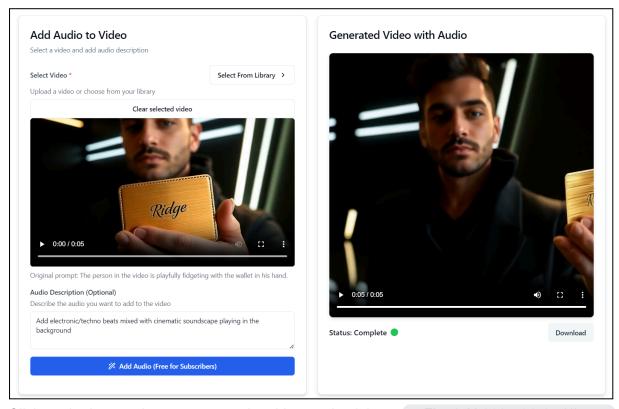

## How to make UGC Ads using Al

Coming up with 100 unique, 30-second scripts is painful. Manually matching 3-second clips (from your 10,000-video library) for every shot of your 100 scripts is even more painful. Creating 3 permutations of each of the 100 ads (for A/B testing) makes the pain even worse.

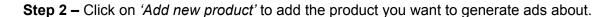
Now imagine voiceovers, captions, music, & uploading all 300 ads to Meta & TikTok on top of this. Also, imagine you're an agency doing this for 10 brands (now we're at 3K ads). Products for scriptwriting, competitor research, creative storage, video editing, creative analytics, & UGC exist, but they're not built for making ads (or just built badly).

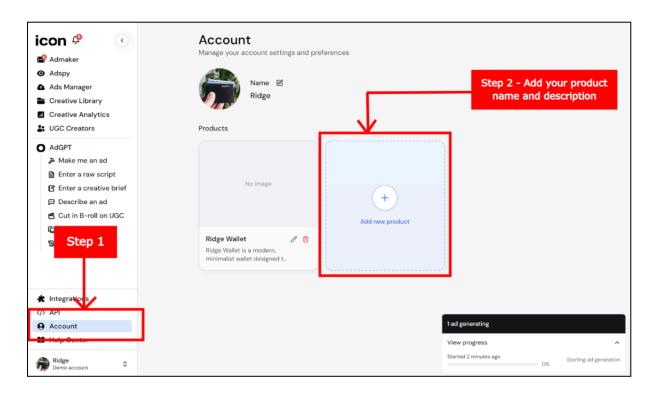

**Step 1 –** Head over to the Account section from the sidebar on the left or click here.





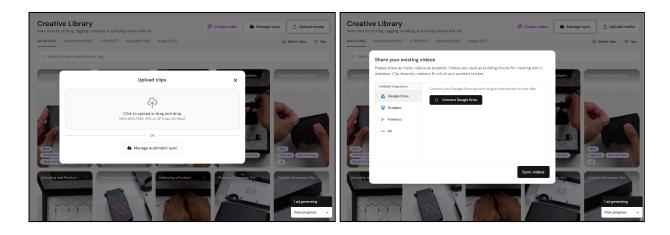
You can add your product website and let Icon fetch your product details, or you can manually submit your product name and description.

## **Creative Library**

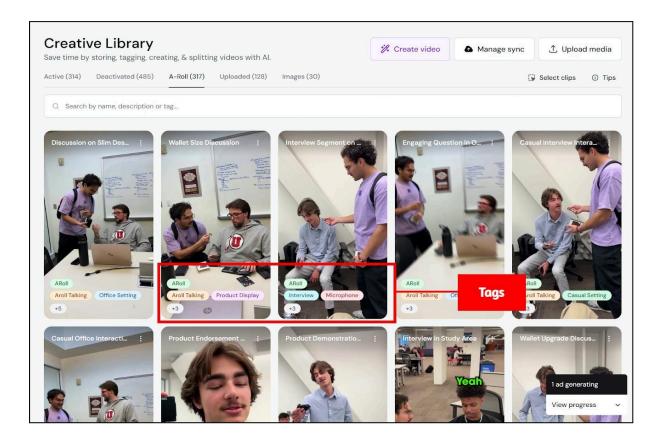
**Step 1 –** Shoot 100+ hours of high-quality photos and videos of your product from different angles or or use the Al-generated creative library we created in the first part of this document.

Step 2 - Upload all your images and videos in the Icon's Creative Library here.

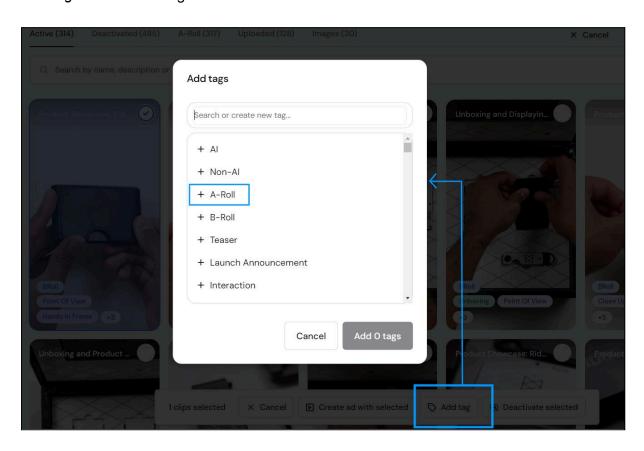
You can also connect with other storage service providers and sync the uploads with Icon. At the moment, Icon supports integration with Google Drive, Dropbox, Frame, and Air.



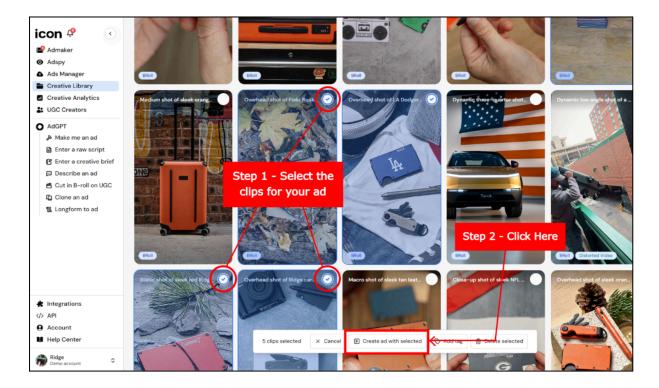
Icon analyzes all the videos and marks each video with relevant tags – Product display, A-roll, B-roll, Office setting, Casual setting, etc.



You can also manually add tags to your videos in the library by selecting the clip and clicking 'Add tag' from the floating bar at the bottom.



**Step 3 –** Select clips that you want to be included in your Al-generated ad and click 'Create an ad with selected'.

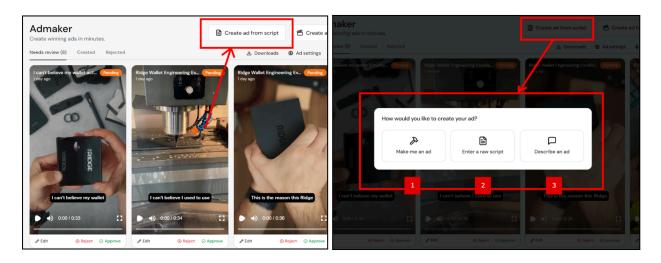


#### **AdGPT**

**Step 1 –** Go to the 'Admaker' tab from the navigation menu on the left and click on 'Create ad from Script' and describe how you want the ad to appear.

You can choose from 3 options:

- 1. **Make me an ad** Let Icon do everything for you from ideation to video
- 2. Enter a script In case you already have a script ready
- 3. Describe an ad Best if you don't have a script but a clear idea about it



The ad editor will show you a sequence of clips in the *Timeline Preview* section along with the complete script for your configured product.

You can also use OpenAl ChatGPT to write an ad script with specific instructions.

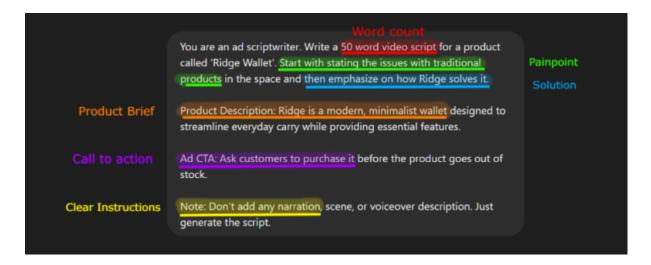
In the case of Ridge Wallet, let's apply the PAS approach for the ad script:

- Pain: Highlight the problem with traditional wallets (bulky, tear, clutter pockets).
- Agitation: Emphasize why this is inconvenient or frustrating.
- Solution: Introduce Ridge Wallet as the sleek, durable fix.

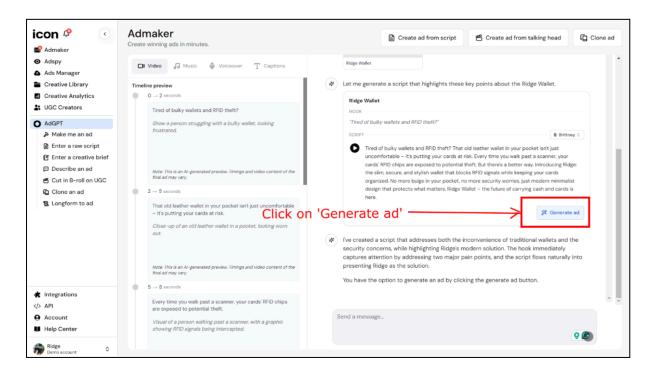
#### Follow these steps to write a perfect prompt:

- 1. Set the control variables Limit the number of words to ensure it is relevant for a short-form content format.
- 2. Describe the pain point of traditional solutions and the solution being offered in the ad. Draw a clear contrast between the two.
- 3. Add a short product brief to give more context about the product.
- 4. Chatgpt by default would give a detailed narration of an advert. If you want to quickly copy-paste and put it in Icon Ad Maker, give additional instructions to avoid narration.

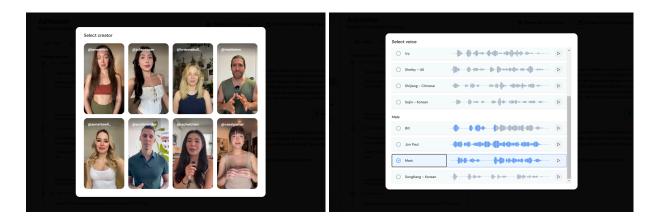
**Prompt**: You are an ad scriptwriter. Write a 50-word video script for a product called 'Ridge Wallet'. Start with stating the issues with traditional products in the space and then emphasize how Ridge solves them. Product Description: Ridge is a modern, minimalist wallet designed to streamline everyday carry while providing essential features. Ad CTA: Ask customers to purchase it before the product goes out of stock. Note: Don't add any narration, scene, or voiceover description. Just generate the script.



**Step 2 –** Make further changes as per your wish in the Ad Editor and then Click on 'Generate ad'. Watch the ad maker refine your script, break it down into 3-second snippets, and plug relevant clips into the Timeline preview.



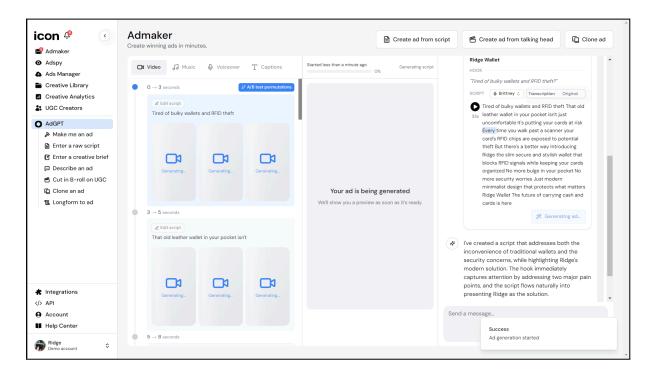
**Step 3 –** Select your preferred ad type (Al UGC ad or Al B-rolls) and choose your favorite voiceover and creator from the dropdown menu.



Icon comes with a bunch of different voices and creators pre-configured in the editor.

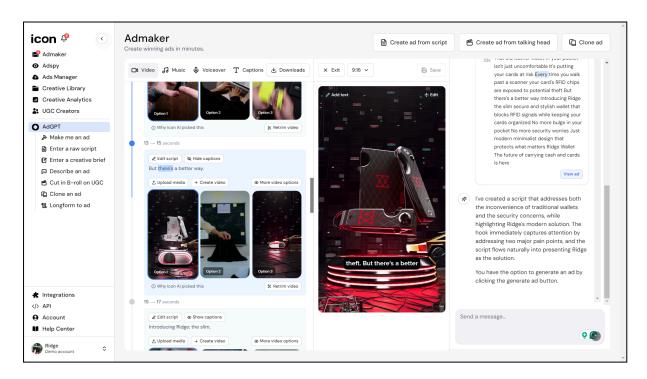
**Step 4 –** Click on 'Generate ad' in the chat window once you have finalized your ad script.

Icon Ad Maker will start generating voiceovers, videos, music, and captions for your ad.

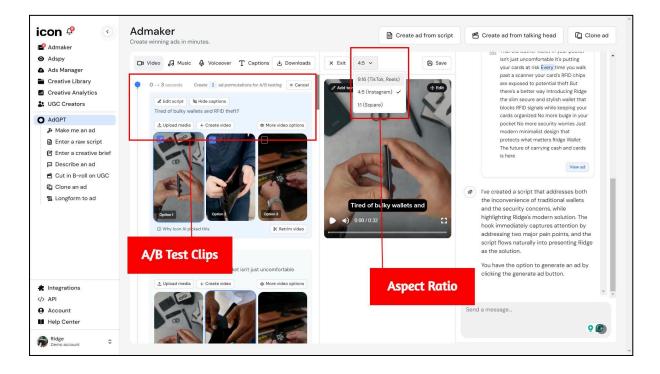


**Note:** Icon Al also understands and explains why a certain clip is best suited for a certain part of the script. More on this later...

**Step 5 –** Edit script, video sequences, and captions, as per your preference. You can even ask Icon to show more video options to replace the existing clip with a different one from your Creative Library.



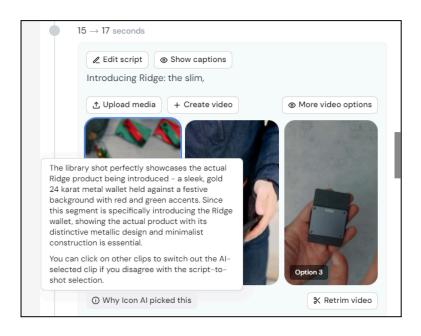
You can even A/B test your hooks and other parts of the video and choose the image specs for your ads based on which platform you are planning to run it.



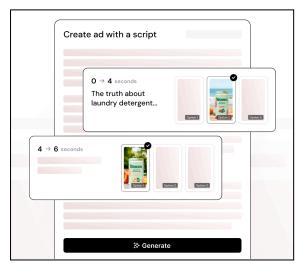
#### Here's the best part!

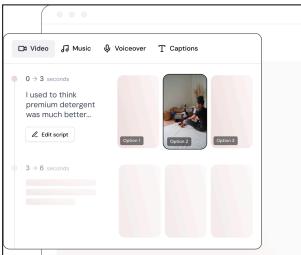
The clip selection for your script is not random and useless like most other AI apps out there. Icon analyzes videos and the snippets of your script to find the best possible associations.

## **AdSpy**

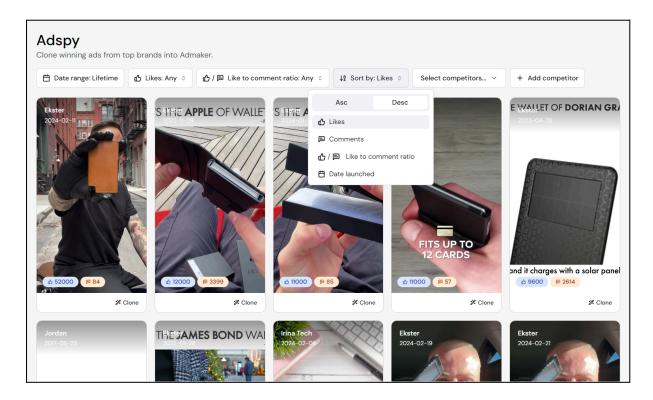
Let's say you love a few ads from your competitor products and want to use them as an inspiration for your brand adverts. Or you think you can even build better ads with the competitor ads laying the groundwork for you to build upon.

This is where Icon AdSpy comes into the picture. Icon helps you save time by cloning winning ads from top brands in your niche. It clones the competitor ads using your videos and bring them to a completion rate of around 80%-95%.

Here's how you can clone ads for yourself:

**Step 1 –** Go to the AdSpy section from the navigation pane on the left. Look up your competitor's products by clicking 'Add Competitor' on the top right.

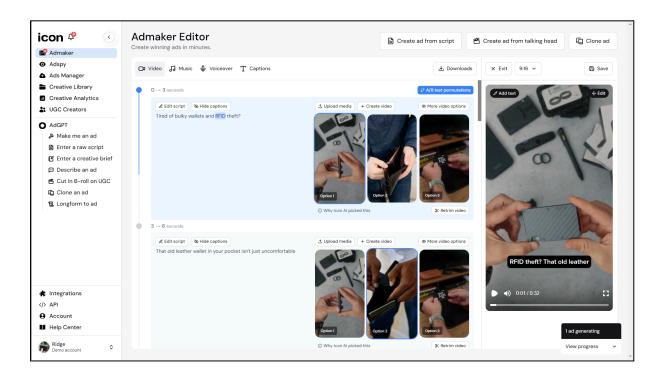
You can also filter and sort the competitor ads based on date range, likes, comments, etc.



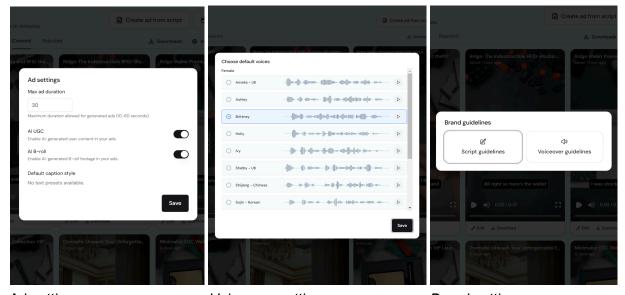
Step 2 - Click on 'Clone' to clone the best ads you found and the Icon AdSpy gets to work

You can configure default settings in the Admaker by clicking on 'Ad settings' to fix an ad duration and clips category, 'Voiceover settings' to fix a default voice, and 'Brand settings' to fix script guidelines and voiceover guidelines.

## **Summary**

There's a remarkable shift happening in content creation – evolving from user-generated content (UGC) to professionally-generated content (PGC), and now to Al-simulated user-generated content (Al UGC).

It is almost a non-negotiable to not be aware of how fast the Al-generated content vertical is expanding but as more and more people jump onto the bandwagon, a new set of challenges has started to emerge.

### Challenges in Generating AI UGC Ads and How to Handle Them

- Lack of Authenticity AI can create great content, but it may lack the genuine, human touch that makes UGC effective.
  - **Solution:** Inject your personality by adding custom touches, like real customer testimonials or behind-the-scenes moments.
- **Difficulty Matching Brand Voice** Al might generate content that feels too generic or doesn't align with your brand's tone.
  - **Solution**: Always refine the script and ensure the messaging aligns with your brand's voice and style.
- Overused Templates Using AI templates can sometimes make your ad look too similar to others, reducing its originality.
  - **Solution**: Mix and match templates, add unique elements, or create custom visuals to stand out.
- **Struggles with Video Length** Al might produce UGC ads that are either too short or too long, impacting viewer engagement.
  - **Solution**: Keep it concise—use Al tools to trim or extend the video to the ideal length based on platform preferences.
- **Difficulty with Dynamic Visuals** Al struggles to generate fast-paced or dynamic visuals that keep attention.
  - **Solution**: Manually add transitions or effects to make the visuals more engaging.

"A good ad will provide useful information. A better ad might make you think. The best ads, however, are so creative that they make you feel."
