Paint Colors

- ☐ Titanium White
- ☐ Yellow Ochre*
- ☐ Cadmium Yellow
- ☐ Cadmium Red
- ☐ Alizarin Crimson*
- ☐ Burnt Umber
- ☐ Ultramarine Blue
- ☐ Ivory Black*
- ☐ Viridian Green

Brushes

- ☐ A selection of bristle and/or natural hair brushes (sizes ranging small to large) -

Recommended brush profiles: filberts,

flats, brights, and rounds

- Some synthetic brushes work well. -

Nylon brushes not recommended.

Painting Mediums

- ☐ Artist Linseed oil, Odorless turpentine. ☐ Liquin - Optional

Brush Cleaner

- ☐ Odorless mineral spirits
(Recommended: Gamsol), or other brush cleaner

Canvas

- ☐ Panels using linen, cotton duck, or polyflex
- For beginners: Michael's sells inexpensive cotton canvases
- Sizes: Smaller sizes recommend. Not to exceed 12"x16"
